## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 PART 204
- 2 SEC. 20401. AS USED IN THIS PART:
- 3 (A) "FUTILITY POLICY" MEANS ANY WRITTEN POLICY THAT ENCOURAGES
  - OR ALLOWS A HEALTH FACILITY OR AGENCY EMPLOYEE, OR OTHER MEDICAL
- 5 PROFESSIONAL WHO PROVIDES CARE TO PATIENTS AT A HEALTH FACILITY OR
  - AGENCY, TO WITHHOLD OR DISCONTINUE TREATMENT FOR A PATIENT ON THE
    - GROUNDS OF MEDICAL FUTILITY.
  - (B) "MEDICAL FUTILITY" MEANS A JUDGMENT THAT FURTHER MEDICAL
- 9 TREATMENT OF A PATIENT WOULD HAVE NO USEFUL RESULT.

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- 1 SEC. 20403. A HEALTH FACILITY OR AGENCY THAT ADOPTS OR
- 2 IMPLEMENTS A FUTILITY POLICY THAT APPLIES TO THE TREATMENT OF A
- 3 CHILD FROM BIRTH TO 18 YEARS OF AGE MUST DISCLOSE THAT FUTILITY
- 4 POLICY TO THE CHILD'S PARENT OR GUARDIAN WHEN THE HEALTH FACILITY
- 5 OR AGENCY IDENTIFIES THE NEED FOR A FORMAL PROCESS TO ADDRESS
- 6 CONCERNS OVER THE PROPOSED TREATMENT OF A CHILD. THE HEALTH
- 7 FACILITY OR AGENCY MUST, UPON REQUEST OF THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF
- 8 A PATIENT OR PROSPECTIVE PATIENT, PROVIDE A COPY OF THE FUTILITY
- 9 POLICY IN PLACE AT THE HEALTH FACILITY OR AGENCY AT THE TIME THE
- 10 REQUEST IS MADE.
