HOUSE BILL No. 4088

January 18, 2011, Introduced by Reps. Genetski, O'Brien, Outman, Hooker, MacGregor, McMillin and Kowall and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 803e (MCL 257.803e), as amended by 2003 PA 30.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 803e. (1) A person who has been a prisoner of war or a person whose spouse has been a prisoner of war may make application to the secretary of state for a special registration plate which

 THAT shall be inscribed with special identification numbers preceded by the letters "EX-POW" and shall have the words "exprisoner of war" inscribed beneath the registration number.
 - (2) A person who was a member of the armed services during World War I may make application to the secretary of state for a special registration plate, which THAT shall be inscribed with special identification numbers preceded by the letters "WWI" and

- 1 shall have the words "World War I veteran" inscribed beneath the
- 2 registration number.
- 3 (3) A person who was a member of the armed services during
- 4 1941, stationed at a United States military or naval establishment
- 5 at Pearl Harbor in the Hawaiian islands, and who survived the
- 6 attack by Japan on Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941 may make
- 7 application to the secretary of state for a special registration
- 8 plate, which THAT shall be inscribed with special identification
- 9 numbers and shall have the words "Pearl Harbor survivor" inscribed
- 10 beneath the registration number.
- 11 (4) A person who is a recipient of the purple heart medal may
- 12 make application to the secretary of state for a special
- 13 registration plate which THAT shall be inscribed with special
- 14 identification numbers and shall have the words "combat wounded
- 15 veteran" inscribed beneath the registration number. In addition,
- 16 the special registration plate described under this subsection
- 17 shall be inscribed with a vignette of the official purple heart
- 18 medal.
- 19 (5) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a
- 20 form prescribed by the secretary of state, and shall be accompanied
- 21 by any proof THAT THE SECRETARY OF STATE MAY REQUIRE of the
- 22 applicant having been a prisoner of war, World War I veteran, Pearl
- 23 Harbor survivor, or recipient of the purple heart medal, that the
- 24 secretary of state may require OR THE SPOUSE, PARENT, SIBLING, OR
- 25 CHILD OF A MEMBER OF THE ARMED SERVICES WHO DIED DURING COMBAT. The
- 26 application for a special registration plate shall also be
- 27 accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee.

- 1 (6) Upon proper application and payment of the \$5.00 service
- 2 fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 or more special
- 3 registration plates for each applicant for use on a passenger
- 4 vehicle. A person who is disabled who makes application for a
- 5 special registration plate under this section and who makes payment
- 6 of the \$5.00 service fee shall be issued a tab for persons with
- 7 disabilities as provided in section 803f for his or her special
- 8 registration plate. The secretary of state shall require the same
- 9 proof that the applicant is a disabled person as is required for
- 10 issuance of a permanent windshield placard under section 675. One
- 11 person in any household is entitled to 1 special registration plate
- 12 issued under subsection (1) that is exempt from payment of the tax
- 13 provided in section 801. The person who is issued an additional
- 14 special registration plate under subsection (1) shall be assessed
- 15 the applicable tax provided for in section 801. A person issued 1
- 16 or more special registration plates under subsection (2), (3), or
- 17 (4), OR (9) shall be assessed the applicable tax provided in
- **18** section 801.
- 19 (7) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other
- 20 than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a person who
- 21 does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.
- 22 (8) The special registration plate issued under this section
- 23 expires on the birthday of the vehicle owner in a year in which new
- 24 plates are issued by the secretary of state. Application for
- 25 renewal of the special registration plate shall be accompanied by a
- 26 \$5.00 service fee. The applicant is not required to furnish the
- 27 proof provided in subsection (5).

- 1 (9) THE SPOUSE, PARENT, SIBLING, OR CHILD OF A MEMBER OF THE
- 2 ARMED SERVICES WHO DIED DURING COMBAT MAY MAKE APPLICATION TO THE
- 3 SECRETARY OF STATE FOR A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE THAT SHALL BE
- 4 INSCRIBED WITH SPECIAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS PRECEDED BY A GOLD
- 5 STAR AND SHALL HAVE THE WORDS "GOLD STAR FAMILY" INSCRIBED BENEATH
- 6 THE REGISTRATION NUMBER.
