

HOUSE BILL No. 4548

April 13, 2011, Introduced by Rep. LeBlanc and referred to the Committee on Redistricting and Elections.

A bill to amend 1895 PA 3, entitled
"The general law village act,"
by amending section 4 of chapter III (MCL 63.4), as added by 1998
PA 255.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

CHAPTER III

Sec. 4. An individual who is a registered elector of the
township in which the village is located and who is a resident of
the village may vote at any election in the village. **FOR PURPOSES
OF REGISTERING TO VOTE AND VOTING AT AN ELECTION OR SPECIAL
ELECTION ON THE QUESTION OF IMPOSING A NEW MILLAGE OR INCREASING OR
RENEWING AN EXISTING MILLAGE ON REAL PROPERTY ONLY, A PERSON IS
CONSIDERED A RESIDENT OF THE VILLAGE TO BE AFFECTED BY THE RESULT
OF THAT ELECTION IF THAT PERSON OWNS REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN THAT**
