HOUSE BILL No. 4683

May 25, 2011, Introduced by Rep. Opsommer and referred to the Committee on Energy and Technology.

A bill to amend 1986 PA 32, entitled "Emergency 9-1-1 service enabling act,"

by amending section 405 (MCL 484.1405), as amended by 2007 PA 165.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 405. (1) The commission shall consult with and consider the recommendations of the committee in the promulgation of rules under section 413 to require each service user with a multiline telephone system to install no later than December 31, 2011 the necessary equipment and software to provide specific location information of a 9-1-1 call. THE FOLLOWING:
 - (A) ALL SERVICE USERS WITH AN EXISTING E 9-1-1 CAPABLE MULTILINE TELEPHONE SYSTEM TO INSTALL, NO LATER THAN DECEMBER 31, 2011 OR 12 MONTHS AFTER THE COMMISSION PROMULGATES RULES UNDER SECTION 413, WHICHEVER IS LATER, THE NECESSARY EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE TO PROVIDE SPECIFIC LOCATION INFORMATION OF A 9-1-1 CALL.
