"An act to regulate and license second hand dealers and junk dealers; and to prescribe penalties for the violation of the provisions of this act,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 445.403), as amended by 2006 PA 675.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 2 (a) "Automotive recycler" means a person who THAT engages in
- 3 business primarily for the purpose of selling retail salvage
- 4 vehicle parts and secondarily for the purpose of selling retail
- 5 salvage motor vehicles or manufacturing or selling a product of
- 6 gradable scrap metal. or a person employed as a salvage vehicle
- 7 agent as that term is defined in section 56c of the Michigan
- 8 vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.56c.
 - (b) "Industrial scrap" means materials that are a direct

- 24 whose principal business is that of purchasing, selling,
- 25 exchanging, storing, or receiving second hand articles of any kind,
- 26 scrap metals, cast iron, old iron, old steel, tool steel, aluminum,
- 27 copper, brass, lead pipe or tools, or lighting and plumbing
