July 27, 2011, Introduced by Rep. Shaughnessy and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled "The social welfare act,"

(MCL 400.1 to 400.119b) by adding section 56j.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 56J. (1) WHEN AN INDIVIDUAL APPLIES FOR ASSISTANCE UNDER
- 2 THIS ACT, IF THE INDIVIDUAL HAS A SCHOOL-AGED CHILD, THE INDIVIDUAL
- 3 SHALL SIGN AN AFFIDAVIT STATING THAT THE CHILD IS ENROLLED IN AND
- 4 IS ATTENDING SCHOOL. THE AFFIDAVIT SHALL INCLUDE THE CHILD'S NAME,
- 5 THE NAME OF THE SCHOOL THE CHILD ATTENDS, AND THE NAME OF THE
- 6 SCHOOL DISTRICT IN WHICH THE SCHOOL IS LOCATED.
 - (2) THE DEPARTMENT MAY REQUIRE CONSENT TO RELEASE THE CHILD'S
- 8 SCHOOL ATTENDANCE RECORDS TO THE DEPARTMENT AS A CONDITION OF
