 - (A) IS AT LEAST 16 YEARS OF AGE BUT LESS THAN 17-1/2 YEARS OF

- 26 YEARS OF AGE, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL SEND A NOTICE THROUGH
- 27 THE QUALIFIED VOTER FILE TO THE APPROPRIATE CITY OR TOWNSHIP CLERK
