SENATE BILL No. 111

February 8, 2011, Introduced by Senator HANSEN and referred to the Committee on Economic Development.

A bill to amend 1996 PA 376, entitled

"Michigan renaissance zone act,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 125.2683), as amended by 2010 PA 277, and by adding section 8i.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Agricultural processing facility" means 1 or more
- 3 facilities or operations that transform, package, sort, or grade
- 4 livestock or livestock products, agricultural commodities, or
- 5 plants or plant products, excluding forest products, into goods
- 6 that are used for intermediate or final consumption including goods
- 7 for nonfood use, and surrounding property.
- **8** (b) "Board" means the state administrative board created in
- 1921 PA 2, MCL 17.1 to 17.3.

- 1 (c) "Border crossing facility" means a business that is 1 or
- 2 more of the following as determined by the board of the Michigan
- 3 strategic fund:
- 4 (i) That was located in a qualified border local governmental
- 5 unit as defined in section 8g and was displaced or otherwise
- 6 negatively affected by the development of the international border
- 7 crossing and is unable to recover from the displacement or negative
- 8 effect without the establishment of a renaissance zone.
- 9 (ii) That is associated with international trade, shipping, or
- 10 freight hauling, including, but not limited to, all of the
- 11 following:
- 12 (A) Customs brokers.
- 13 (B) Distribution centers.
- 14 (C) Truck supply and repair.
- 15 (d) "Development plan" means a written plan that addresses the
- 16 criteria in section 7 and includes all of the following:
- 17 (i) A map of the proposed renaissance zone that indicates the
- 18 geographic boundaries, the total area, and the present use and
- 19 conditions generally of the land and structures within those
- 20 boundaries.
- 21 (ii) Evidence of community support and commitment from
- 22 residential and business interests.
- 23 (iii) A description of the methods proposed to increase economic
- 24 opportunity and expansion, facilitate infrastructure improvement,
- 25 and identify job training opportunities.
- 26 (iv) Current social, economic, and demographic characteristics
- 27 of the proposed renaissance zone and anticipated improvements in

- 1 education, health, human services, public safety, and employment if
- 2 the renaissance zone is created.
- 3 (v) Any other information required by the board.
- 4 (e) "Elected county executive" means the elected county
- 5 executive in a county organized under 1966 PA 293, MCL 45.501 to
- 6 45.521, or 1973 PA 139, MCL 45.551 to 45.573.
- 7 (f) "Eligible next Michigan business" means a business engaged
- 8 in the shipment of tangible personal property via multimodal
- 9 commerce; a supply chain business providing a majority of its
- 10 services to businesses engaged in the shipment of tangible personal
- 11 property, including inventory, via multimodal commerce; a
- 12 manufacturing or assembly facility receiving a majority of its
- 13 production components via multimodal commerce; a manufacturing or
- 14 assembly facility shipping a majority of products via multimodal
- 15 commerce; or a light manufacturing or assembly facility that
- 16 packages, kits, labels, or customizes products and ships those
- 17 products via multimodal commerce.
- 18 (G) "ENTREPRENEURIAL BUSINESS" MEANS 1 OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 19 (i) A NEW, FOR-PROFIT START-UP BUSINESS OF 100 EMPLOYEES OR
- 20 LESS REGISTERED IN AND WITH THIS STATE ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2010.
- 21 (ii) AN EXISTING BUSINESS THAT DOES 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING
- 22 AS DETERMINED BY THE BOARD OF THE MICHIGAN STRATEGIC FUND:
- 23 (A) INCREASES THE SIZE OF ITS FACILITY BY 25% OR MORE.
- 24 (B) INCREASES THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES AT ITS FACILITY BY 25%
- 25 OR MORE.
- 26 (C) INCREASES THE AMOUNT OF CAPITAL INVESTMENT AT ITS
- 27 FACILITY.

- 1 (H) "ENTREPRENEURIAL BUSINESS FACILITY" MEANS A FACILITY OR
- 2 OPERATION THAT HAS AS ITS PRINCIPAL FUNCTION THE RESEARCH,
- 3 DEVELOPMENT, SUPPORT, MANUFACTURING, OR PROVIDING A SERVICE FOR AN
- 4 ENTREPRENEURIAL BUSINESS.
- 5 (I) (g) "Forest products processing facility" means 1 or more
- 6 facilities or operations that transform, package, sort, recycle, or
- 7 grade forest or paper products into goods that are used for
- 8 intermediate or final use or consumption or for the creation of
- 9 biomass or alternative fuels through the utilization of forest
- 10 products or forest residue, and surrounding property. Forest
- 11 products processing facility does not include an existing facility
- 12 or operation that is located in this state that relocates to a
- 13 renaissance zone for a forest products processing facility. Forest
- 14 products processing facility does not include a facility or
- 15 operation that engages primarily in retail sales.
- 16 (J) (h) "Local governmental unit" means a county, city,
- 17 village, township, or, for taxes levied after 2009, any other
- 18 taxing jurisdiction that levies an ad valorem property tax.
- 19 (K) (i) "Multimodal commerce" means the movement of products
- 20 or services via 2 or more of the following:
- 21 (i) Air.
- **22** (*ii*) Road.
- 23 (*iii*) Rail.
- (iv) Water.
- 25 (l) (j)—"Next Michigan development corporation" means that term
- 26 as defined in section 3 of the next Michigan development act, 2010
- 27 PA 275, MCL 125.2953.

- 1 (M) (k) "Next Michigan development district" means that term
- 2 as defined in section 3 of the next Michigan development act, 2010
- 3 PA 275, MCL 125.2953.
- 4 (N) (l) "Next Michigan renaissance zone" means a renaissance
- 5 zone created under section 8h.
- 6 (O) (m)—"Person" means an individual, partnership,
- 7 corporation, association, limited liability company, governmental
- 8 entity, or other legal entity.
- 9 (P) (n) "Qualified eligible next Michigan business" means an
- 10 eligible next Michigan business that has been certified in
- 11 accordance with section 8h.
- (Q) (O) "Qualified local governmental unit" means either of
- 13 the following:
- 14 (i) A county.
- 15 (ii) A city, village, or township that contains an eligible
- 16 distressed area as defined in section 11 of the state housing
- 17 development authority act of 1966, 1966 PA 346, MCL 125.1411.
- (R) (p) "Recovery zone" means a tool and die renaissance
- 19 recovery zone created in section 8d.
- 20 (S) (q) "Renaissance zone" means a geographic area designated
- 21 under this act.
- 22 (T) (r) "Renewable energy facility" means a facility that
- 23 creates energy, fuels, or chemicals directly from the wind, the
- 24 sun, trees, grasses, biosolids, algae, agricultural commodities,
- 25 processed products from agricultural commodities, or residues from
- 26 agricultural processes, wood or forest processes, food production
- 27 and processing, or the paper products industry. Renewable energy

- 1 facility also includes a facility that creates energy, fuels, or
- 2 chemicals from solid biomass, animal wastes, or landfill gases.
- 3 Renewable energy facility also includes a facility that focuses on
- 4 research, development, or manufacturing of systems or components of
- 5 systems used to create energy, fuel, or chemicals from the items
- 6 described in this subdivision. Renewable energy facility also
- 7 includes a facility that focuses on research, development, or
- 8 manufacturing of systems or components of systems that involve the
- 9 conversion of chemical energy for advanced battery technology.
- 10 (U) (s)—"Residential rental property" means that term as
- 11 defined in section 7ff of the general property tax act, 1893 PA
- 12 206, MCL 211.7ff.
- 13 (V) (t) "Review board" means the renaissance zone review board
- 14 created in section 5.
- 15 (W) (u) "Rural area" means an area that lies outside of the
- 16 boundaries of an urban area.
- 17 (X) (v)—"Urban area" means an urbanized area as determined by
- 18 the economics and statistics administration, United States bureau
- 19 of the census according to the 1990 census.
- 20 SEC. 8I. (1) THE BOARD, UPON RECOMMENDATION OF THE BOARD OF
- 21 THE MICHIGAN STRATEGIC FUND DEFINED IN SECTION 4 OF THE MICHIGAN
- 22 STRATEGIC FUND ACT, 1984 PA 270, MCL 125.2004, MAY DESIGNATE
- 23 ADDITIONAL RENAISSANCE ZONES FOR ENTREPRENEURIAL BUSINESS
- 24 FACILITIES WITHIN THIS STATE IN THAT PORTION OF A CITY, VILLAGE, OR
- 25 TOWNSHIP IF THAT CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP OR COMBINATION OF
- 26 CITIES, VILLAGES, OR TOWNSHIPS CONSENTS TO THE CREATION OF A
- 27 RENAISSANCE ZONE FOR AN ENTREPRENEURIAL BUSINESS FACILITY WITHIN

- 1 THEIR BOUNDARIES. A RENAISSANCE ZONE FOR AN ENTREPRENEURIAL
- 2 BUSINESS FACILITY SHALL HAVE A DURATION OF RENAISSANCE ZONE STATUS
- 3 FOR A PERIOD OF 5 YEARS.
- 4 (2) EACH RENAISSANCE ZONE DESIGNATED FOR AN ENTREPRENEURIAL
- 5 BUSINESS FACILITY UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE 1 CONTINUOUS DISTINCT
- 6 GEOGRAPHIC AREA.
- 7 (3) THE BOARD MAY REVOKE THE DESIGNATION OF ALL OR A PORTION
- 8 OF A RENAISSANCE ZONE FOR AN ENTREPRENEURIAL BUSINESS FACILITY IF
- 9 THE BOARD DETERMINES THAT THE ENTREPRENEURIAL BUSINESS FACILITY
- 10 DOES 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING IN A RENAISSANCE ZONE DESIGNATED
- 11 UNDER THIS SECTION:
- 12 (A) FAILS TO COMMENCE OPERATION.
- 13 (B) CEASES OPERATION.
- 14 (C) FAILS TO COMMENCE CONSTRUCTION OR RENOVATION WITHIN 1 YEAR
- 15 FROM THE DATE THE RENAISSANCE ZONE FOR THE ENTREPRENEURIAL BUSINESS
- 16 FACILITY IS DESIGNATED.
- 17 (4) THE BOARD SHALL CONSIDER ALL OF THE FOLLOWING WHEN
- 18 DESIGNATING A RENAISSANCE ZONE FOR AN ENTREPRENEURIAL BUSINESS
- 19 FACILITY:
- 20 (A) THE ECONOMIC IMPACT ON LOCAL SUPPLIERS WHO SUPPLY RAW
- 21 MATERIALS, GOODS, AND SERVICES TO THE ENTREPRENEURIAL BUSINESS
- 22 FACILITY.
- 23 (B) THE CREATION OF JOBS RELATIVE TO THE EMPLOYMENT BASE OF
- 24 THE COMMUNITY RATHER THAN THE STATIC NUMBER OF JOBS CREATED.
- 25 (C) THE VIABILITY OF THE PROJECT.
- 26 (D) THE ECONOMIC IMPACT ON THE COMMUNITY IN WHICH THE
- 27 ENTREPRENEURIAL BUSINESS FACILITY IS LOCATED.

- 1 (5) THE BOARD SHALL REQUIRE A DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN
- 2 THE MICHIGAN STRATEGIC FUND AND THE ENTREPRENEURIAL BUSINESS
- 3 FACILITY.
- 4 (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT" MEANS A
- 5 WRITTEN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE MICHIGAN STRATEGIC FUND AND THE
- 6 ENTREPRENEURIAL BUSINESS FACILITY THAT INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED
- 7 TO, ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 8 (A) A REQUIREMENT THAT THE ENTREPRENEURIAL BUSINESS FACILITY
- 9 COMPLY WITH ALL STATE AND LOCAL LAWS.
- 10 (B) A REQUIREMENT THAT THE ENTREPRENEURIAL BUSINESS FACILITY
- 11 REPORT ANNUALLY TO THE MICHIGAN STRATEGIC FUND ON ALL OF THE
- 12 FOLLOWING:
- 13 (i) THE AMOUNT OF CAPITAL INVESTMENT MADE AT THE FACILITY.
- 14 (ii) THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS EMPLOYED AT THE FACILITY AT THE
- 15 BEGINNING AND END OF THE REPORTING PERIOD AS WELL AS THE NUMBER OF
- 16 INDIVIDUALS TRANSFERRED TO THE FACILITY FROM ANOTHER FACILITY OWNED
- 17 BY THE ENTREPRENEURIAL BUSINESS FACILITY.
- 18 (iii) THE PERCENTAGE OF RAW MATERIALS PURCHASED IN THIS STATE.
- 19 (C) APPROVAL OF THE BUSINESS PLAN BY A STATE RECOGNIZED
- 20 ENTREPRENEURIAL SUPPORT RESOURCE AS DETERMINED BY THE BOARD.
- 21 (D) ANY OTHER CONDITIONS OR REQUIREMENTS REASONABLY REQUIRED
- 22 BY THE MICHIGAN STRATEGIC FUND.
