UNDER THIS ACT SHALL ARRANGE FOR AN INDEPENDENT EXTERNAL PEER

REVIEW OF EACH SUCH PROGRAM TO EVALUATE ITS EFFICIENCY AND

EFFECTIVENESS AS WELL AS HOW IT COMPARES TO SIMILAR PROGRAMS IN

OTHER STATES.
