

# SENATE BILL No. 325

April 13, 2011, Introduced by Senators WARREN, PAPPAGEORGE, ANDERSON, CASPERSON, SCHUITMAKER, MARLEAU, BRANDENBURG, HILDENBRAND, BOOHER, JONES, PAVLOV, GREGORY, HUNE, PROOS, JANSEN and ROBERTSON and referred to the Committee on Finance.

A bill to establish the Michigan Alzheimer's association fund in the department of treasury; to provide for the distribution of the money from the fund; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain agencies and officials; and to provide for appropriations.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the  
2 "Michigan Alzheimer's association fund act".

3       Sec. 3. As used in this act:

4       (a) "Department" means the department of treasury.

5       (b) "Fund" means the Michigan Alzheimer's association fund  
6 created in section 5.

7       Sec. 5. (1) The Michigan Alzheimer's association fund is  
8 created in the department to provide funds to benefit the programs  
9 and services for unpaid caregivers of individuals with Alzheimer's

1 disease provided by the greater Michigan chapter and the Michigan  
2 Great Lakes chapter of the Alzheimer's association. The department  
3 shall be the administrator of the fund for auditing purposes.

4 (2) The state treasurer shall credit to the fund all amounts  
5 appropriated for this purpose under section 435 of the income tax  
6 act of 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.435, and money from any other  
7 source for deposit into the fund.

8 (3) The state treasurer shall direct the investment of the  
9 fund. The fund shall consist of the money credited to the fund  
10 pursuant to section 435 of the income tax act of 1967, 1967 PA 281,  
11 MCL 206.435, any interest and earnings accruing from the saving and  
12 investment of that money, and money from any other source.

13 (4) Money in the fund at the close of the year shall remain in  
14 the fund and shall not lapse to the general fund.

15 Sec. 7. The money, interest, and earnings of the fund shall be  
16 expended solely for donation to the greater Michigan chapter of the  
17 Alzheimer's association for distribution to the greater Michigan  
18 and Michigan Great Lakes chapters of the Alzheimer's association.

19 Sec. 9. The money in the fund that is available for  
20 distribution shall be appropriated each year. Money granted or  
21 received as a gift or donation to the fund is available for  
22 distribution upon appropriation.

23 Enacting section 1. This act does not take effect unless  
24 Senate Bill No. 324 of  
25 the 96th Legislature is enacted into law.
