

SENATE BILL No. 375

May 12, 2011, Introduced by Senators BIEDA, JONES, SCHUITMAKER and ROCCA and referred to the Committee on Reforms, Restructuring and Reinventing.

A bill to establish the terms upon which health benefits may be provided to legislators.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
2 "legislative health benefits act".

3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:

4 (a) "Health coverage" means hospital, medical-surgical, sick
5 care, dental, optical, and hearing benefits.

6 (b) "Legislator" means a person duly elected and serving in
7 the senate or house of representatives of this state.

8 Sec. 3. Beginning January 1, 2013, this state shall pay not
9 more than 75% of the costs of any health coverage it provides to a
10 legislator during the legislator's term of office.
