

SENATE BILL No. 423

June 9, 2011, Introduced by Senators JONES, BIEDA, ROCCA, KOWALL, MARLEAU, BRANDENBURG, PAPPAGEORGE and ANDERSON and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.

A bill to amend 1969 PA 287, entitled

"An act to regulate pet shops, animal control shelters, and animal protection shelters; to establish uniform procedures and minimum requirements for adoption of dogs, cats, and ferrets; and to prescribe penalties and civil fines and to provide remedies,"

(MCL 287.331 to 287.340) by adding section 8b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 8B. (1) WHEN EUTHANIZING A DOG OR CAT THAT IS UNDER THE
2 CONTROL OF AN ANIMAL CONTROL SHELTER OR ANIMAL PROTECTION SHELTER,
3 A PERSON SHALL ONLY USE AN INJECTION OF A COMMERCIALY PREPARED
4 SOLUTION AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 7333 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE,
5 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.7333.

6 (2) THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION DO NOT APPLY TO OR
7 PROHIBIT THE LAWFUL KILLING OR OTHER USE OF AN ANIMAL IN FARMING OR
8 A GENERALLY ACCEPTED ANIMAL HUSBANDRY OR FARMING PRACTICE INVOLVING
9 LIVESTOCK.

10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect January

1 1, 2012.
