THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 2 ANTIEPILEPTIC DRUG OR FORMULATION OF AN ANTIEPILEPTIC DRUG THAT IS

SEC. 17769. A PHARMACIST SHALL NOT INTERCHANGE AN

- 3 PRESCRIBED FOR THE TREATMENT OF EPILEPSY OR THE TREATMENT OR
- 4 PREVENTION OF SEIZURES WITHOUT THE PRIOR NOTIFICATION OF AND THE
- 5 SIGNED INFORMED CONSENT TO THE INTERCHANGE BY THE PRESCRIBING
  - PHYSICIAN AND THE PATIENT OR THE PATIENT'S PARENT, LEGAL GUARDIAN,
  - SPOUSE, OR OTHER LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE. AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
    - (A) "ANTIEPILEPTIC DRUG" MEANS A DRUG OR THERAPEUTIC
- 9 FORMULATION, GENERIC OR BRAND, PRESCRIBED FOR THE TREATMENT OF
- 10 EPILEPSY OR THE TREATMENT OR PREVENTION OF SEIZURES.

- 2 (C) "INTERCHANGE" MEANS THE SUBSTITUTION OF 1 VERSION OF AN
- 3 ANTIEPILEPTIC DRUG FOR THE ANTIEPILEPTIC DRUG ORIGINALLY
- 4 PRESCRIBED, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, A GENERIC VERSION FOR
- 5 THE PRESCRIBED BRAND, A BRAND VERSION FOR THE PRESCRIBED GENERIC, A
- 6 GENERIC VERSION BY 1 MANUFACTURER FOR THE PRESCRIBED GENERIC BY A
- 7 DIFFERENT MANUFACTURER, A DIFFERENT FORMULATION OF AN ANTIEPILEPTIC
- 8 DRUG FOR THE PRESCRIBED ANTIEPILEPTIC DRUG, OR A DIFFERENT
- 9 ANTIEPILEPTIC THERAPEUTIC DRUG PRODUCT FOR THE PRESCRIBED
- 10 ANTIEPILEPTIC DRUG.
- 11 (D) "SEIZURE" MEANS AN ACUTE CLINICAL CHANGE SECONDARY TO A
- 12 BRIEF DISTURBANCE IN THE ELECTRICAL ACTIVITY OF THE BRAIN.
