## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 34. (1) Except as provided in this section and section 36, an individual required to be registered under article II shall not do 1 or more of the following:
  - (a) Work within a student safety zone.

- 5 (b) Loiter within a student safety zone OR WITHIN 1,000 FEET
  6 OF A CHILD CARE ORGANIZATION, AS THAT TERM IS DEFINED UNDER SECTION
  7 1 OF 1973 PA 116, MCL 722.111.
  - (2) An individual who violates this section is guilty of a crime as follows:
  - (a) For the first violation, the individual is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 1 year or

- 1 a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both.
- 2 (b) An individual who violates this section and has 1 or more

- 6 (3) Subsection (1)(a) does not apply to any of the following:

- 21 (4) This section does not prohibit an individual from being
- 22 charged with, convicted of, or punished for any other violation of
- 23 law that is committed by that individual while violating this
- 24 section.
- 25 (5) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit an
- 26 individual from exercising his or her right to vote.
