

# SENATE BILL No. 542

June 29, 2011, Introduced by Senators EMMONS, PROOS, HANSEN, GREEN, NOFS, JONES, PAPPAGEORGE, BRANDENBURG and BIEDA and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled  
"Revised judicature act of 1961,"  
(MCL 600.101 to 600.9947) by adding section 2977.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1        SEC. 2977. AN ACTION FOR DAMAGES FOR PERSONAL INJURY, DEATH,  
2        OR PROPERTY DAMAGE SHALL NOT BE COMMENCED AGAINST A PERSON ENGAGED  
3        IN A LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS BUSINESS IF THE INJURY, DEATH, OR  
4        PROPERTY DAMAGE WAS CAUSED BY EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:

5        (A) AN ALTERATION, MODIFICATION, OR REPAIR OF A LIQUEFIED  
6        PETROLEUM GAS SYSTEM OR APPLIANCE MADE WITHOUT THE KNOWLEDGE OR  
7        CONSENT OF THE PERSON ENGAGED IN A LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS  
8        BUSINESS.

9        (B) THE USE OF A LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS SYSTEM OR APPLIANCE  
10       IN A MANNER OR FOR A PURPOSE OTHER THAN THE MANNER IN WHICH OR THE

1 PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE SYSTEM OR APPLIANCE WAS INTENDED TO BE USED,  
2 UNLESS THE USE COULD REASONABLY HAVE BEEN EXPECTED BY THE PERSON  
3 ENGAGED IN A LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS BUSINESS.
