THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 17241. (1) An institution seeking to conduct a nursing education program to prepare individuals for licensing shall apply to the board and submit evidence that it is prepared:OF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
 - (a) $\overline{\mbox{To-THAT}}$ IT IS PREPARED TO carry out the minimum curriculum prescribed by the board in rules for the preparation of individuals for licensing.
 - (b) To THAT IT IS PREPARED TO meet ANY other educational and training standards established by the board under this article and the rules promulgated under this article.
