THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 234e. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a person shall not knowingly brandish a firearm OR AN OBJECT THAT APPEARS TO BE A FIREARM in public.
 - (2) Subsection (1) does not apply to any of the following:
 - (a) A peace officer lawfully performing his or her duties as a peace officer.
 - (b) A person lawfully engaged in hunting.

- (c) A person lawfully engaged in target practice.
- (d) A person lawfully engaged in the sale, purchase, repair, or transfer of that firearm.
