

SENATE BILL No. 1032

March 20, 2012, Introduced by Senator BOOHER and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for the department of treasury for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.
