SENATE BILL No. 1086

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 9208 (MCL 333.9208), as amended by 2000 PA 90.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 9208. (1) A parent, guardian, or person in loco parentis

applying to have a child registered for the first time in a school in this state and, beginning in 2002-2003, 2012-2013, a parent, guardian, or person in loco parentis of a child entering the sixth SEVENTH grade, shall present to school officials, at the time of registration or not later than the first day of school, a certificate of immunization or statement of exemption under section 9215.

(2) A teacher or principal shall not permit a child to enter or attend school unless a certificate indicating that a minimum of 1 dose of an immunizing agent against each of the diseases
