SENATE BILL No. 1242

September 11, 2012, Introduced by Senator EMMONS and referred to the Committee on Families, Seniors and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1973 PA 116, entitled

"An act to provide for the protection of children through the licensing and regulation of child care organizations; to provide for the establishment of standards of care for child care organizations; to prescribe powers and duties of certain departments of this state and adoption facilitators; to provide penalties; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

by amending sections 2a and 10 (MCL 722.112a and 722.120), section 2a as amended by 2007 PA 217 and section 10 as amended by 2006 PA 206.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 2a. (1) A child caring institution, child care center,

FAMILY CHILD CARE HOME, or group child care home shall have on duty
at all times while the institution, center, or home is providing
care to 1 or more children at least 1 person who has been certified
within the preceding 36 months—IS CURRENTLY CERTIFIED in first aid
and within the preceding 12 months—in age-appropriate
