SENATE BILL No. 1250

September 11, 2012, Introduced by Senator HUNE and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.

A bill to amend 1992 PA 239, entitled "Pseudorabies and swine brucellosis control and eradication act," by amending section 33 (MCL 287.833).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 33. (1) Brucellosis or pseudorabies positive swine shall be traced to the herd of origin. The director shall notify the owner of the herd of origin within 60 days after the date the
- 4 department is notified of positive swine. HOWEVER, IF A FERAL SWINE
- 5 IS DETERMINED TO BE BRUCELLOSIS OR PSEUDORABIES POSITIVE, THE
- 6 DIRECTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE HERD OF ORIGIN AND ANY HERD THAT IS
- 7 LOCATED WITHIN 5 MILES OF THE LOCATION WHERE THE FERAL SWINE WAS
- 8 KILLED OR CAPTURED.
 - (2) When the herd of origin **OR OTHER HERD** has been identified **UNDER SUBSECTION (1)**, the owner of the swine herd in this state shall, upon request by the director, make available his or her

- 1 swine for an official test for the detection of brucellosis or
- 2 pseudorabies and shall provide the necessary facilities for
- 3 handling and restraining the swine, and shall render any reasonable
- 4 assistance required by the director. The department shall provide
- 5 personnel and assume expense for the collection and analysis of
- 6 samples. HOWEVER, IF THE TESTING IS REQUIRED BECAUSE A FERAL SWINE
- 7 WAS DETERMINED TO BE BRUCELLOSIS OR PSEUDORABIES POSITIVE, THE
- 8 OWNER OF THE FERAL SWINE SHALL ASSUME ALL EXPENSES FOR THE
- 9 COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS OF SAMPLES REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.
