## **SENATE BILL No. 330**

April 14, 2011, Introduced by Senator HUNE and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.

A bill to amend 2000 PA 92, entitled "Food law of 2000,"

by amending section 4102 (MCL 289.4102), as added by 2010 PA 112.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4102. (1) A cottage food operation is exempt from the
- 2 licensing and evaluation provisions of this act. This exemption
- 3 does not include an exemption from the adulteration and other
- 4 standards imposed in this section or under this act, or both, and
- 5 does not limit the ability of the department to take appropriate
- 6 enforcement action for applicable violations as described in
- section 5101. This subsection does not require a cottage food
- 8 operation to meet the standards contained in 21 CFR 110 or the 2005

- 2 (2) Cottage food products shall be prepackaged and properly
- 3 labeled prior to sale.
- 4 (3) At a minimum, a cottage food operation shall place on the
- 5 label of any food it produces or packages the following

- 7 (a) The name and address of the business of the cottage food
- 8 operation.
- 9 (b) The name of the cottage food product.
- 10 (c) The ingredients of the cottage food product, in descending
- 11 order of predominance by weight.
- 12 (d) The net weight or net volume of the cottage food product.
- (e) Allergen labeling as specified by federal labeling
- 14 requirements.
- 15 (f) If any nutritional claim is made, appropriate labeling as
- 16 specified by federal labeling requirements.
- 17 (g) The following statement printed in at least the equivalent
- 18 of 11-point font size in a color that provides a clear contrast to
- 19 the background: "Made in a home kitchen that has not been inspected
- 20 by the Michigan department of agriculture."
- 21 (4) Cottage food products may ONLY be sold directly from the
- 22 cottage food operation to the consumer, only, and not by internet
- 23 or mail order. Sales by consignment or at wholesale are prohibited.
- 24 (5) The gross sales of cottage food products BY A COTTAGE FOOD
- 25 OPERATION shall not exceed \$15,000.00 \$75,000.00 annually. The
- 26 determination of the \$15,000.00 annual ANNUAL gross sales shall be
- 27 computed on the basis of the amount of gross sales within or at a

- 1 particular domestic residence and shall not be computed on a per-
- 2 person basis within or at that domestic residence. The department
- 3 may request in writing documentation to verify the annual gross
- 4 sales figure.
- **5** (6) Cottage food products shall be stored only in the primary
- 6 domestic residence.
- 7 (7) An exemption under this section does not affect the
- 8 application of any other state or federal laws or any applicable
- 9 ordinances enacted by any local unit of government.
