A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled $\label{eq:parameters} \mbox{"The social welfare act,"}$ (MCL 400.1 to 400.119b) by adding sections 14k and 14l.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 14K. A RETAILER OR MERCHANT SHALL NOT BUY OR SELL FOOD
- 2 ASSISTANCE BENEFITS FOR CASH OR OTHER ITEMS BESIDES ELIGIBLE FOOD.
- 3 A RETAILER OR MERCHANT WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO A
- 4 FINE OF UP TO \$5,000.00 FOR EACH OFFENSE. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS
- 5 SECTION DO NOT PRECLUDE PROSECUTION OR OTHER ACTION UNDER ANY OTHER
- 6 CRIMINAL OR CIVIL STATUTE.
- 7 SEC. 141. SUBJECT TO ANY REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED IN FEDERAL
- 8 STATUTE, RULE, OR REGULATION, ANY PERSON WHO HAS BEEN FOUND BY A
- 9 STATE OR FEDERAL COURT OR ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY IN A HEARING UNDER
 - THIS ACT TO HAVE INTENTIONALLY SOLD ANY FOOD THAT WAS PURCHASED
