

SENATE BILL No. 508

June 21, 2011, Introduced by Senators CASPERSON, WALKER, HANSEN, MOOLENAAR, BOOHER, ROCCA, PAPPAGEORGE, MARLEAU, SCHUITMAKER, PROOS, WARREN, HOPGOOD, BIEDA, SMITH, YOUNG, CASWELL, GREEN, MEEKHOF, NOFS, KOWALL, JANSEN and JONES and referred to the Committee on Outdoor Recreation and Tourism.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
(MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding sections 41401 and 41411.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

SEC. 41401. AS USED IN THIS PART:

(A) "AIS" MEANS AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES.

(B) "COUNCIL" MEANS THE AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES ADVISORY
COUNCIL CREATED IN SECTION 41405.

(C) "DRAFT NEXT VESSEL GENERAL PERMIT" MEANS THE DRAFT PERMIT
THAT THE EPA PREPARES AND PUBLISHES NOTICE OF IN ACCORDANCE WITH 40
CFR 124.6 AND OTHER APPLICABLE REGULATIONS BEFORE ISSUING THE NEXT
VESSEL GENERAL PERMIT.

(D) "EPA" MEANS UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY.

(E) "GREAT LAKES COMMISSION" MEANS THE GREAT LAKES COMMISSION

1 CREATED BY THE GREAT LAKES BASIN COMPACT ESTABLISHED BY JOINT
2 LEGISLATIVE ACTION OF THE GREAT LAKES STATES IN 1955 AND GRANTED
3 CONGRESSIONAL CONSENT THROUGH PUBLIC LAW 90-419.

4 (F) "GREAT LAKES STATES" MEANS MICHIGAN, ILLINOIS, INDIANA,
5 MINNESOTA, NEW YORK, OHIO, PENNSYLVANIA, AND WISCONSIN.

6 (G) "NEXT VESSEL GENERAL PERMIT" MEANS THE PERMIT THE EPA
7 ISSUED TO SUPERSEDE THE VESSEL GENERAL PERMIT.

8 (H) "VESSEL GENERAL PERMIT" MEANS THE GENERAL PERMIT ENTITLED
9 "FINAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES)
10 GENERAL PERMIT FOR DISCHARGES INCIDENTAL TO THE NORMAL OPERATION OF
11 A VESSEL" ANNOUNCED AT 73 FR 79,473 (DECEMBER 29, 2008).

12 SEC. 41411. THE COUNCIL SHALL DEVELOP RECOMMENDATIONS
13 REGARDING THIS STATE'S COMMENTS ON THE DRAFT NEXT VESSEL GENERAL
14 PERMIT AND CERTIFICATION RESPONSE TO THE DRAFT NEXT VESSEL GENERAL
15 PERMIT UNDER SECTION 401 OF TITLE IV OF THE FEDERAL WATER POLLUTION
16 CONTROL ACT, 33 USC 1341, INCLUDING A PROPOSED BALLAST WATER
17 TREATMENT STANDARD. THE COUNCIL SHALL PROVIDE ITS RECOMMENDATIONS
18 TO THE GOVERNOR UPON REQUEST. SUCH RECOMMENDATIONS ARE NONBINDING
19 AND ADVISORY IN NATURE AND MAY BE USED AT THE DISCRETION OF AND IN
20 THE MANNER DETERMINED BY THE GOVERNOR. THE COUNCIL'S
21 RECOMMENDATIONS UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE SUITABLE FOR USE BY THE
22 EXECUTIVE BRANCH IN COLLABORATING WITH OTHER GREAT LAKES STATES TO
23 ACHIEVE A CONSISTENT POSITION ON THE DRAFT NEXT VESSEL GENERAL
24 PERMIT. IN DEVELOPING ITS RECOMMENDATIONS, THE COUNCIL SHALL
25 REGULARLY CONSULT WITH THE GREAT LAKES COMMISSION AND THE
26 DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY, INCLUDING THE OFFICE OF THE
27 GREAT LAKES.
