A bill to amend 1887 PA 128, entitled

"An act establishing the minimum ages for contracting marriages; to require a civil license in order to marry and its registration; to provide for the implementation of federal law; and to provide a penalty for the violation of this act,"

by amending section 4 (MCL 551.104).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. (1) It shall be the duty of the clergyman or
- 2 magistrate, THE INDIVIDUAL officiating at a marriage , to SHALL
- 3 fill in the spaces of the certificate left blank for the entry of

- 5 place of the marriage, the names and residences of 2 witnesses, and
- 5 his OR HER own signature in certification that the marriage has
- been performed by him and any and all information OR HER.
