## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 20174. (1) AN EMPLOYEE OF A HEALTH FACILITY OR AGENCY IS
- 2 EXEMPT FROM IMMUNIZATION OTHERWISE MANDATED BY THE HEALTH FACILITY
- 3 AGENCY WITHOUT RECOURSE OR TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT, IF THE
- 4 EMPLOYEE STATES IN WRITING THAT HE OR SHE REFUSES IMMUNIZATIONS DUE
- 5 TO RELIGIOUS CONVICTIONS OR OTHER CONSCIENTIOUS OBJECTION TO THE
- 6 MANDATED IMMUNIZATION.
- 7 (2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY DURING THE PERIOD OF TIME WHEN
- 8 THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION DESIGNATES AN OUTBREAK OF A DISEASE
- 9 AS A "PHASE 6 OUTBREAK" FOR THAT SPECIFIC DISEASE AND THE HEALTH
  - FACILITY OR AGENCY IS TRYING TO CONTROL OR RESPOND TO THAT
