## **HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION ZZ**

June 14, 2012, Introduced by Rep. Olumba and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A joint resolution proposing an amendment to the state constitution of 1963, by amending section 6 of article VIII, to require the establishment of an African-American university as a public university and provide for its financial support.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the state of Michigan, That the following amendment to the state constitution of 1963, to require the establishment of an African-American university as a public university and provide for its financial support, is proposed, agreed to, and submitted to the people of the state:

ARTICLE VIII

Sec. 6. Other THE LEGISLATURE SHALL PROVIDE BY LAW FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN AFRICAN-AMERICAN UNIVERSITY AS AN INSTITUTION

- 1 OF HIGHER EDUCATION HAVING AUTHORITY TO GRANT BACCALAUREATE DEGREES
- 2 AND PROVIDE FOR ITS FINANCIAL SUPPORT. THAT INSTITUTION, AND OTHER
- 3 institutions of higher education established by law having
- 4 authority to grant baccalaureate degrees, shall each be governed by
- 5 a board of control which shall be a body corporate. The board shall
- 6 have general supervision of the institution and the control and
- 7 direction of all expenditures from the institution's funds. It
- 8 EACH BOARD OF CONTROL shall, as often as necessary, elect a
- 9 president of the institution under its supervision. He THE
- 10 PRESIDENT shall be the principal executive officer of the
- 11 institution and be ex-officio a member of the board without the
- 12 right to vote. The board may elect one of its members or may
- 13 designate the president, to preside at board meetings.
- 14 Each board of control shall consist of eight members who shall
- 15 hold office for terms of eight years, not more than two of which
- 16 shall expire in the same year, and who shall be appointed by the
- 17 governor by and with the advice and consent of the senate.
- 18 Vacancies shall be filled in like manner.
- 19 AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE TERM "AFRICAN-AMERICAN
- 20 UNIVERSITY" MEANS A PUBLIC UNIVERSITY THAT HAS A MISSION THAT
- 21 REFLECTS A COMMITMENT TO PROMOTING HIGHER EDUCATION AMONG AFRICAN-
- 22 AMERICANS.
- 23 Resolved further, That the foregoing amendment shall be
- 24 submitted to the people of the state at the next general election
- 25 in the manner provided by law.
