

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION P

March 15, 2011, Introduced by Reps. Rendon, Kurtz, Crawford, McBroom, Haugh, Zorn, Lane, Opsommer, Bumstead, Cotter, Huuki, Hughes, Foster, Hooker, Yonker, Daley, Johnson, Lyons and Franz and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, Tourism, and Outdoor Recreation.

A joint resolution proposing an amendment to the state constitution of 1963, by adding section 28 to article I, to recognize a right to hunt, trap, or fish for, and to harvest, game or fish.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the state of Michigan, That the following amendment to the state constitution of 1963, to recognize a right to hunt, trap, or fish for, and to harvest, game or fish, is proposed, agreed to, and submitted to the people of the state:

ARTICLE I

SEC. 28. (1) SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS ESTABLISHED BY LAW AND BASED ON PRINCIPLES OF SCIENTIFIC MANAGEMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, THE PEOPLE HAVE THE RIGHT TO HUNT, TRAP, OR FISH FOR, AND TO

1 HARVEST, GAME OR FISH THAT ARE THE PROPERTY OF THE STATE AND ARE
2 HELD IN THE PUBLIC TRUST.

3 (2) THE STATE SHALL KEEP LAND OR WATER UNDER ITS CONTROL OPEN
4 TO HUNTING, TRAPPING, AND FISHING REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THERE IS
5 ADEQUATE STAFF OR FUNDING TO MANAGE THAT LAND OR WATER.

6 Resolved further, That the foregoing amendment shall be
7 submitted to the people of the state at the next general election
8 in the manner provided by law.
