## **CONTENT**

The bill would amend the Revised Judicature Act to require the party filing an action regarding the custody, support, or parenting time of a minor child, to pay the appropriate fee at the time of filing the action. Currently, the party must pay the fee before entry of a final judgment or order.

The bill also would require a party to pay a \$150 filing fee before filing a civil action. Currently, before a civil action is commenced, the party bringing the action must pay the fee.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

Most counties already collect the appropriate fees at the time an action is filed, so for these counties the bill would have a limited impact as it would only codify current practice. For counties that do not collect the fees at the time of filing, the bill would have a minor positive fiscal impact by accelerating the revenue from this source.
