## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 4. A county levying a tax under this act may provide in
- 2 the ordinance for 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:
- (a) The adoption and enforcement of rules to apply, interpret,
  effectuate, and administer the ordinance and the purposes of the
  tax.
- 6 (b) The prescribing and furnishing to taxpayers of forms,
- 7 instructions, manuals, and other materials necessary for
- indorsement of the tax and the auditing of tax returns.

- 1 (c) The examination by the administrator or his agent of the
- 2 books and records of a taxpayer for purposes of determining the
- 3 correctness of a tax return or information filed, or the
- 4 determination of any tax liability thereunder. UNDER THIS ACT.
- 5 (d) The imposition of a fine of not more than \$500.00, or
- 6 imprisonment of not more than 90 days, or both for violation of the
- 7 ordinance.
- 8 (E) IF THE TAX IMPOSED UNDER THIS ACT REMAINS UNPAID FOR MORE
- 9 THAN 90 DAYS, THE TREASURER OF THE COUNTY MAY COLLECT THE TAX IN
- 10 THE SAME MANNER AS A DELINQUENT SPECIAL ASSESSMENT, ALONG WITH ANY
- 11 ASSOCIATED INTEREST, FEES, AND COSTS, UNDER THE GENERAL PROPERTY
