HOUSE BILL No. 4047

January 22, 2013, Introduced by Rep. Kowall and referred to the Committee on Elections and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 388, entitled "Michigan campaign finance act,"

by amending sections 2, 5, and 11 (MCL 169.202, 169.205, and 169.211), section 2 as amended by 2001 PA 250, section 5 as amended by 1999 PA 237, and section 11 as amended by 2012 PA 273, and by adding section 48.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 2. (1) "AUTOMATED TELEPHONIC COMMUNICATION" MEANS ANY OUTBOUND TELEPHONE CALL THAT PLAYS A RECORDED MESSAGE TO PROMOTE, ADVERTISE, OR CAMPAIGN FOR OR AGAINST A POLITICAL CANDIDATE OR A POLITICAL ISSUE.
 - (2) (1)—"Award" means a plaque, trophy, certificate, bust, ceremonial gavel, or memento.
 - (3) $\frac{(2)}{}$ "Ballot question" means a question that is submitted

- 1 or is intended to be submitted to a popular vote at an election
- 2 whether or not it qualifies for the ballot.
- 3 (4) (3)—"Ballot question committee" means a committee acting
- 4 in support of, or in opposition to, the qualification, passage, or
- 5 defeat of a ballot question but that does not receive contributions
- 6 or make expenditures or contributions for the purpose of
- 7 influencing or attempting to influence the action of the voters for
- 8 or against the nomination or election of a candidate.
- 9 (5) (4) "Bundle" means for a bundling committee to deliver 1
- 10 or more contributions from individuals to the candidate committee
- 11 of a candidate for statewide elective office, without the money
- 12 becoming money of the bundling committee.
- 13 (6) (5) "Bundling committee" means an independent committee or
- 14 political committee that makes an expenditure to solicit or collect
- 15 from individuals contributions that are to be part of a bundled
- 16 contribution, which expenditure is required to be reported as an
- 17 in-kind expenditure for a candidate for statewide elective office.
- 18 (7) (6)—"Business" means a corporation, limited liability
- 19 company, partnership, sole proprietorship, firm, enterprise,
- 20 franchise, association, organization, self-employed individual,
- 21 holding company, joint stock company, receivership, trust,
- 22 activity, or entity that is organized for profit or nonprofit
- 23 purposes.
- 24 Sec. 5. (1) "Domestic dependent sovereign" means an Indian
- 25 tribe that has been acknowledged, recognized, restored, or
- 26 reaffirmed as an Indian tribe by the secretary of the interior
- 27 pursuant to chapter 576, 48 Stat. 984, 25 U.S.C. USC 461 to 463,

- 1 464 to 465, 466 to 470, 471 to 472, 473, 474 to 475, 476 to 478,
- 2 and 479, commonly referred to as the Indian reorganization act, or
- 3 has otherwise been acknowledged by the United States government as
- 4 an Indian tribe.
- 5 (2) "DO-NOT-CALL LIST" MEANS A DO-NOT-CALL LIST OF INDIVIDUALS
- 6 DESIGNATED BY THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION CONCERNING AUTOMATED
- 7 TELEPHONIC COMMUNICATIONS.
- 8 (3) (2) "Election" means a primary, general, special, or
- 9 millage election held in this state or a convention or caucus of a
- 10 political party held in this state to nominate a candidate.
- 11 Election includes a recall vote.
- 12 (4) (3) "Election cycle" means 1 of the following:
- 13 (a) For a general election, the period beginning the day
- 14 following the last general election in which the office appeared on
- 15 the ballot and ending on the day of the general election in which
- 16 the office next appears on the ballot.
- 17 (b) For a special election, the period beginning the day a
- 18 special general election is called or the date the office becomes
- 19 vacant, whichever is earlier, and ending on the day of the special
- 20 general election.
- 21 (5) (4) "Elective office" means a public office filled by an
- 22 election. A person who is appointed to fill a vacancy in a public
- 23 office that is ordinarily elective holds an elective office.
- 24 Elective office does not include the office of precinct delegate.
- 25 Except for the purposes of sections 47, 54, and 55, elective office
- 26 does not include a school board member in a school district that
- 27 has a pupil membership of 2,400 or less enrolled on the most recent

- 1 pupil membership count day. However, elective office includes a
- 2 school board member in a school district that has a pupil
- 3 membership of 2,400 or less, if a candidate committee of a
- 4 candidate for the office of school board member in that school
- 5 district receives an amount in excess of \$1,000.00 or expends an
- 6 amount in excess of \$1,000.00. Elective office does not include a
- 7 federal office except for the purposes of section 57.
- 8 Sec. 11. (1) "Payroll deduction plan" means any system in
- 9 which an employer deducts any amount of money from the wages,
- 10 earnings, or compensation of an employee.
- 11 (2) "Person" means a business, individual, proprietorship,
- 12 firm, partnership, joint venture, syndicate, business trust, labor
- 13 organization, company, corporation, association, committee, or any
- 14 other organization or group of persons acting jointly.
- 15 (3) "Political committee" means a committee that is not a
- 16 candidate committee, political party committee, independent
- 17 committee, or ballot question committee.
- 18 (4) "Political merchandise" means goods such as bumper
- 19 stickers, pins, hats, beverages, literature, or other items sold by
- 20 a person at a fund-raiser or to the general public for publicity or
- 21 for the purpose of raising funds to be used in supporting or
- 22 opposing a candidate for nomination for or election to an elective
- 23 office, in supporting or opposing the qualification, passage, or
- 24 defeat of a ballot question, or in supporting or opposing the
- 25 qualification of a new political party.
- 26 (5) "Political party" means a political party that has a right
- 27 under law to have the names of its candidates listed on the ballot

- 1 in a general election.
- 2 (6) "Political party committee" means a state central,
- 3 district, or county committee of a political party or a party
- 4 attempting to qualify as a new political party under section 685 of
- 5 the Michigan election law, 1954 PA 116, MCL 168.685, that is a
- 6 committee. Each state central committee shall designate the
- 7 official party county and district committees. There shall not be
- 8 more than 1 officially designated political party committee per
- 9 county and per congressional district.
- 10 (7) "POLITICAL SOLICITOR" MEANS A PERSON WHO MAKES OR CAUSES
- 11 TO BE MADE AN AUTOMATIC TELEPHONIC COMMUNICATION.
- 12 (8) (7) "Public body" means 1 or more of the following:
- 13 (a) A state agency, department, division, bureau, board,
- 14 commission, council, authority, or other body in the executive
- 15 branch of state government.
- 16 (b) The legislature or an agency, board, commission, or
- 17 council in the legislative branch of state government.
- 18 (c) A county, city, township, village, intercounty, intercity,
- 19 or regional governing body; a council, school district, special
- 20 district, or municipal corporation; or a board, department,
- 21 commission, or council or an agency of a board, department,
- 22 commission, or council.
- 23 (d) Any other body that is created by state or local authority
- 24 or is primarily funded by or through state or local authority, if
- 25 the body exercises governmental or proprietary authority or
- 26 performs a governmental or proprietary function.
- 27 SEC. 48. (1) WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE

- 1 AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION, THE COMMISSION SHALL DO 1
- 2 OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 3 (A) ESTABLISH A STATE DO-NOT-CALL LIST CONCERNING AUTOMATED
- 4 TELEPHONIC COMMUNICATIONS. IF THE COMMISSION ESTABLISHES A STATE
- 5 DO-NOT-CALL LIST UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION, IT SHALL PUBLISH THAT LIST
- 6 OUARTERLY FOR USE BY POLITICAL SOLICITORS. THE COMMISSION MAY AT
- 7 ANY TIME CEASE TO MAINTAIN A LIST UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION AND MAKE A
- 8 DESIGNATION UNDER SUBDIVISION (B).
- 9 (B) INVESTIGATE ANY NATIONAL DO-NOT-CALL LISTS THEN IN
- 10 EXISTENCE AND AFTER CONSIDERATION OF EACH LIST'S ACCESSIBILITY TO
- 11 POLITICAL SOLICITORS, EASE AND COST OF REGISTRATION FOR INDIVIDUALS
- 12 SEEKING INCLUSION, AND THE LIST TRANSFER POLICIES OF THE LIST
- 13 KEEPER, DESIGNATE A LIST AS THE AUTHORIZED DO-NOT-CALL LIST. THE
- 14 COMMISSION MAY REVIEW AND MAKE A DIFFERENT DESIGNATION UNDER THIS
- 15 SUBDIVISION AT ANY TIME IF THE COMMISSION DETERMINES THAT AN
- 16 ALTERNATIVE DO-NOT-CALL LIST PROVIDES SUPERIOR ACCESSIBILITY TO
- 17 POLITICAL SOLICITORS AND EASE AND COST OF REGISTRATION FOR
- 18 INDIVIDUALS SEEKING INCLUSION OR IF THE ORGANIZATION MAINTAINING A
- 19 PREVIOUSLY DESIGNATED DO-NOT-CALL LIST ENGAGES IN ACTIVITIES THE
- 20 COMMISSION CONSIDERS CONTRARY TO THE PUBLIC INTEREST. THE
- 21 COMMISSION MAY AT ANY TIME DISCONTINUE A DESIGNATION UNDER THIS
- 22 SUBDIVISION AND ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN A LIST UNDER SUBDIVISION
- 23 (A).
- 24 (2) IN DETERMINING WHETHER TO ESTABLISH OR DESIGNATE A DO-NOT-
- 25 CALL LIST UNDER SUBSECTION (1), OR IN DESIGNATING A DO-NOT-CALL
- 26 LIST UNDER SUBSECTION (1)(B), THE COMMISSION SHALL CONSIDER
- 27 COMMENTS FROM INDIVIDUALS, POLITICAL SOLICITORS, OR ANY OTHER

- 1 PERSON.
- 2 (3) BEGINNING 90 DAYS AFTER THE COMMISSION ESTABLISHES OR
- 3 DESIGNATES A DO-NOT-CALL LIST UNDER SUBSECTION (1), A POLITICAL
- 4 SOLICITOR SHALL NOT MAKE OR CAUSE TO BE MADE AN AUTOMATED
- 5 TELEPHONIC COMMUNICATION FROM WITHIN THIS STATE TO AN INDIVIDUAL
- 6 WHOSE NAME IS ON THE THEN-CURRENT VERSION OF THE DO-NOT-CALL LIST.
- 7 (4) A POLITICAL SOLICITOR SHALL NOT USE A DO-NOT-CALL LIST FOR
- 8 ANY PURPOSE OTHER THAN MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (3).
- 9 A POLITICAL SOLICITOR SHALL NOT SELL OR TRANSFER A DO-NOT-CALL LIST
- 10 TO ANY PERSON FOR ANY PURPOSE UNRELATED TO THIS SECTION.
- 11 (5) IF THE COMMISSION ESTABLISHES AND MAINTAINS THE DO-NOT-
- 12 CALL LIST UNDER SUBSECTION (1), THE COMMISSION SHALL NOT SELL OR
- 13 TRANSFER THE DO-NOT-CALL LIST TO ANY PERSON FOR ANY PURPOSE
- 14 UNRELATED TO THIS SECTION.
- 15 (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "COMMISSION" MEANS THE PUBLIC
- 16 SERVICE COMMISSION.
