"Condominium act,"

by amending section 57 (MCL 559.157).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 57. (1) The books, records, and contracts, AND FINANCIAL STATEMENTS concerning the administration and operation of the condominium project shall be available for examination by any of the co-owners and their mortgagees at convenient times. and all books and records shall be audited or reviewed by independent accountants annually. Such audits need not be certified.

7 (2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (3), AN ASSOCIATION OF
8 CO-OWNERS WITH ANNUAL REVENUES GREATER THAN \$100,000.00 SHALL ON AN

 AMERICAN INSTITUTE OF CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANTS.
