THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
 "earned income tax credit notification act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
 - (a) "Department" means the department of treasury.
 - (b) "EITC" means the federal earned income tax credit.
 - (c) "Eligibility information" means information designated by the department under section 4 concerning eligibility requirements for the EITC.
 - (d) "Employee" means an individual who is employed by an employer for compensation.

- 4 Sec. 3. (1) Not later than January 31 of each year, an
