

HOUSE BILL No. 5111

October 29, 2013, Introduced by Rep. Price and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled
"The revised school code,"
(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1280f.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 1280F. (1) BEGINNING IN THE 2014-2015 SCHOOL YEAR, IF A
2 PUPIL ENROLLED IN GRADE 3 IN A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR PUBLIC SCHOOL
3 ACADEMY DOES NOT ACHIEVE A SCORE OF AT LEAST PROFICIENT IN READING
4 ON THE GRADE 3 STATE ASSESSMENT, THE BOARD OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT
5 OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY IN WHICH THE
6 PUPIL IS ENROLLED SHALL ENSURE THAT THE PUPIL IS NOT ENROLLED IN
7 GRADE 4 UNTIL THE PUPIL ACHIEVES A SCORE OF AT LEAST PROFICIENT IN
8 READING ON THE GRADE 3 STATE ASSESSMENT.

9 (2) IF A CHILD SEEKS TO ENROLL FOR THE FIRST TIME IN A SCHOOL
10 DISTRICT OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY IN GRADE 4, THE SCHOOL DISTRICT

1 OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL NOT ALLOW THE PUPIL TO ENROLL IN
2 GRADE 4 UNLESS THE PUPIL HAS ACHIEVED A SCORE OF AT LEAST
3 PROFICIENT IN READING ON THE GRADE 3 STATE ASSESSMENT.
