8 GENERAL SECTIONS

- 9 Sec. 201. In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of
- 10 article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending
- 11 from state resources in this appropriation act for the fiscal year
- 12 ending September 30, 2014 is \$10,000,000.00 and state

18 DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE

- 19 Sec. 301. (1) The funds appropriated in part 1 for emergency
- 20 management freeze damage shall be allocated in order to alleviate
- 21 the burden placed upon the municipalities and counties in the Upper
- 22 Peninsula experiencing damage to water mains, sewer lines, and
- 23 other public infrastructure due to the prolonged period of time in
- 24 which temperatures were below freezing and the resulting increase,

- 1 and subsequent thaw, of ground frost. Counties and municipalities
- 2 may apply for assistance grants to the department under this
- 3 section. Reimbursement for expenditures shall be limited to public
- 4 damage and direct loss as a result of the prolonged freeze. To be
- 5 eligible for grant assistance, applicants must meet the following

- 11 (b) Implement the applicable emergency operations plan in a
- 12 timely manner before the disaster or emergency.
- 13 (c) Certify the exhaustion of local effort, including the
- 14 utilization of all available and applicable disaster relief forces
- 15 as identified in the emergency operations plan.
- 16 (d) Demonstrate a financial hardship.
- 17 (e) Conduct an assessment of damages that are incurred in the
- 18 disaster or emergency and forward the assessment to the department
- 19 in accordance with standards and procedures established by the
- 20 department.
- 21 (f) Declare a local state of emergency in a timely manner, as
- 22 provided under section 10 of the emergency management act, 1976 PA
- 23 390, MCL 30.410.
- 24 (2) Any unexpended amounts appropriated for emergency
- 25 management freeze damage are considered work project
- 26 appropriations and are available for expenditure in succeeding
- 27 fiscal years. The following is in compliance with section 451a(1)

- 1 of the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:
- 2 (a) The purpose of this project is to provide assistance to
- 3 municipalities and counties affected by damage resulting from the
- 4 prolonged freeze.
- 5 (b) The project will be accomplished by state employees, local
- 6 employees, and contracts.
- 7 (c) The total estimated cost of the project is \$10,000,000.00.
- 8 (d) The tentative completion date of the project is September
- **9** 30, 2018.
