A bill to amend 1919 PA 339, entitled "Dog law of 1919,"

by amending the title and section 1 (MCL 287.261), as amended by 1996 PA 63, and by adding section 30a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

An act relating to dogs and DOMESTIC ANIMALS USED AS PETS; TO PROVIDE FOR the protection of live stock—LIVESTOCK and poultry from damage by dogs; providing—TO PROVIDE for the licensing of dogs AND OTHER DOMESTIC ANIMALS; regulating—TO REGULATE the keeping of dogs, and authorizing their destruction in certain cases; providing—TO PROVIDE for the determination and payment of damages done by dogs to live stock—LIVESTOCK and poultry; imposing—TO PRESCRIBE THE powers and duties on—OF certain state, county, city, and township
