

HOUSE BILL No. 5620

June 4, 2014, Introduced by Rep. Oakes and referred to the Committee on Elections and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled
"Michigan election law,"
(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding section 931b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 931B. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT PROVIDE FALSE INFORMATION TO
2 A REGISTERED ELECTOR THAT THE PERSON KNOWS TO BE FALSE AND THAT IS
3 INTENDED TO IMPEDE THE REGISTERED ELECTOR IN EXERCISING HIS OR HER
4 RIGHT TO VOTE AT AN ELECTION. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION, "FALSE
5 INFORMATION" INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

6 (A) THE DATE OR TIME OF AN ELECTION.

7 (B) THE LOCATION OF A VOTING PRECINCT OR POLLING PLACE.

8 (C) THE REGISTRATION STATUS OF A REGISTERED ELECTOR.

9 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
10 MISDEMEANOR.
