

# HOUSE BILL No. 5828

September 18, 2014, Introduced by Reps. Hobbs and Stallworth and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1980 PA 299, entitled  
"Occupational code,"  
(MCL 339.101 to 339.2677) by adding section 1440.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           **SEC. 1440. (1) THE CLASSROOM TRAINING DESCRIBED IN SECTION**  
2           **1439(B) SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, THE FOLLOWING**  
3           **SUBJECTS:**

4           **(A) A MINIMUM OF 6 HOURS OF COMPANY AND POSITION ORIENTATION**  
5           **THAT INCLUDES MINIMUM UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS AND APPEARANCE; LIMITS**  
6           **OF AUTHORITY AND EMPLOYMENT; LEGAL ASPECTS OF THE USE OF FORCE AND**  
7           **THE POWER TO ARREST; PERSONS OR AUTHORITIES TO BE CONTACTED IN**  
8           **EMERGENCIES OR UNUSUAL OCCURRENCES; LICENSEE OR PARENT COMPANY**  
9           **STRUCTURE THAT AFFECTS GUARDS' DUTIES; GUARD COURTESY AND PUBLIC**  
10           **DEMEANOR; AND REPORT WRITING.**

1 (B) A MINIMUM OF 8 HOURS INVOLVING DEFENSIVE TACTICS THAT  
2 INCLUDE SELF-DEFENSE; CORRECT USE OF A RESTRAINT DEVICE IF THE  
3 LICENSEE HAS OR INTENDS TO AUTHORIZE HIM OR HER TO USE A RESTRAINT  
4 DEVICE WHILE ON DUTY; PRESSURE POINT TRAINING; DETECTION OF  
5 SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND MENTAL ILLNESS; AND VERBAL AND SENSITIVITY  
6 TRAINING.

7 (C) A MINIMUM OF 2 HOURS REGARDING EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS THAT  
8 INCLUDES THE GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES PERTAINING TO MEDICAL  
9 EMERGENCIES AND RESPONSE; FIRST AID AND CARDIOPULMONARY  
10 RESUSCITATION, AND FOREIGN BODY OBSTRUCTION OF THE AIRWAY; CROWD  
11 CONTROL; EXPOSURE TO BODILY FLUID; FIRE PREVENTION AND SAFETY; BOMB  
12 THREATS; SEARCHES; WEATHER EMERGENCIES; CHEMICAL SPILLS, LEAKS, AND  
13 RELATED WASTE; AND EVACUATION PROCEDURES.

14 (2) A LICENSEE SHALL PREPARE AND RETAIN A RECORD OF AN  
15 INDIVIDUAL'S COMPLETION OF THE TRAINING DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION  
16 AND SECTION 1439 AND MAKE THAT RECORD AVAILABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT  
17 ON REQUEST.

18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
19 after the date it is enacted into law.

20 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect  
21 unless all of the following bills of the 97th Legislature are  
22 enacted into law:
