## **HOUSE BILL No. 5988**

December 2, 2014, Introduced by Rep. Victory and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend 2000 PA 246, entitled

"Wolf-dog cross act,"

by amending sections 18 and 20 (MCL 287.1018 and 287.1020).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 18. (1) A law enforcement officer may return a seized wolf-dog cross to the owner of the wolf-dog cross if the law enforcement officer is satisfied that the conditions resulting in the seizure have been corrected. If the wolf-dog cross was seized pursuant to process issued by a court, the law enforcement officer shall obtain approval of the court before returning the wolf-dog cross.

- 1 (2) Unless the wolf-dog cross has been returned, the law
- 2 enforcement officer shall, within 10 days after the wolf-dog cross
- 3 is seized, give written notice of the seizure and intent to forfeit
- 4 the wolf-dog cross to each of the following persons:
- 5 (a) The owner of the wolf-dog cross.
- 6 (b) Each person with a known ownership interest in the wolf-
- 7 dog cross.
- 8 (c) Any person who was injured or whose property was damaged
- **9** by the wolf-dog cross.
- 10 (3) The BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2015, THE notice required under
- 11 subsection (2) shall be delivered in person or sent by certified
- 12 mail. If BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2015, IF the name and address of the
- 13 person are not reasonably ascertainable or personal delivery of the
- 14 notice cannot reasonably be accomplished, the notice shall be
- 15 published in a newspaper of general circulation in the county in
- 16 which the wolf-dog cross was seized for 10 successive publishing
- 17 days. BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2015, THE NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER
- 18 SUBSECTION (2) SHALL BE PROVIDED BY SENDING THE NOTICE BY CERTIFIED
- 19 MAIL AND BY TIER B PUBLIC NOTICE AS PROVIDED IN THE LOCAL
- 20 GOVERNMENT PUBLIC NOTICE ACT. Proof of written notice or
- 21 publication shall be filed with the court having jurisdiction over
- 22 the seizure or forfeiture.
- 23 (4) The law enforcement officer shall immediately after
- 24 seizure of the wolf-dog cross notify the prosecuting attorney for
- 25 the county in which the wolf-dog cross was seized or, if the
- 26 attorney general is actively handling a case involving or relating
- 27 to the wolf-dog cross, the attorney general of the seizure of the

- 1 wolf-dog cross and any intent to forfeit the wolf-dog cross under
- 2 this act.
- 3 Sec. 20. (1) A law enforcement officer shall return a seized
- 4 wolf-dog cross to the owner of the wolf-dog cross within 7 days
- 5 after the occurrence of any of the following:
- 6 (a) The failure to issue a warrant against the owner or person
- 7 temporarily in possession of the wolf-dog cross for committing a
- 8 misdemeanor under section 15 or to file a complaint under section
- 9 16(3) within 10 days after the wolf-dog cross is seized.
- 10 (b) The dismissal of charges against the owner or person
- 11 temporarily in possession of the wolf-dog cross under section 15 or
- of a complaint under section 16(3), as applicable.
- 13 (c) The court's determination that an order for the wolf-dog
- 14 cross to be forfeited shall not be entered.
- 15 (d) The acquittal of the owner or person temporarily in
- 16 possession of the wolf-dog cross of any charges under section 15.
- 17 (e) Entry of a court order under this act for the return of
- 18 the wolf-dog cross.
- 19 (2) If a wolf-dog cross is returned under subsection (1), the
- 20 law enforcement officer shall give written notice to the persons
- 21 who received notice under section 18 that the wolf-dog cross has
- 22 been returned. The BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2015, THE notice under this
- 23 subsection shall be delivered in person or sent by certified mail.
- 24 If BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2015, the name and address of the person are
- 25 not reasonably ascertainable or personal delivery of the notice
- 26 cannot reasonably be accomplished, the notice shall be published in
- 27 a newspaper of general circulation in the county in which the wolf-

- 1 dog cross was seized for 10 successive publishing days. BEGINNING
- 2 JANUARY 1, 2015, THE NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE
- 3 PROVIDED BY SENDING THE NOTICE BY CERTIFIED MAIL AND BY TIER B
- 4 PUBLIC NOTICE AS PROVIDED IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT PUBLIC NOTICE
- 5 ACT.
- 6 (3) If the court orders a wolf-dog cross to be forfeited, the
- 7 order of forfeiture shall direct that each wolf-dog cross be
- 8 transferred to a wildlife sanctuary approved by the association of
- 9 sanctuaries, an animal protection shelter, or a zoo accredited by
- 10 the American zoo and aquarium association, where the wolf-dog cross
- 11 will be safely and humanely cared for as provided by this act.
- 12 However, subject to section 10, if the wolf-dog cross killed or
- 13 injured a human or an animal, the order of forfeiture may direct
- 14 that the wolf-dog cross be humanely euthanized by a veterinarian.
- 15 An order of forfeiture shall also revoke any permit that may have
- 16 been issued for the wolf-dog cross under section 4 and order
- 17 payment of costs under subsection (4). The forfeiture is a civil
- 18 forfeiture.
- 19 (4) If a wolf-dog cross is seized, the owner of the wolf-dog
- 20 cross is liable for the costs of placement and care for the wolf-
- 21 dog cross from the time of seizure until the time of return or
- 22 forfeiture and, if a wolf-dog cross is ordered to be forfeited and
- 23 euthanized, for the costs of humanely euthanizing and disposing of
- 24 the wolf-dog cross. This subsection does not apply if the wolf-dog
- 25 cross is returned under subsection (1) or section 19.
- 26 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 27 unless Senate Bill No. \_\_\_\_ or House Bill No. 5560 (request no.

1 03796'13) of the 97th Legislature is enacted into law.
