## **SENATE BILL No. 795**

February 19, 2014, Introduced by Senators KOWALL, PAVLOV, WALKER, MEEKHOF and BIEDA and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, Environment and Great Lakes.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
by amending sections 41305, 41309, and 47361 (MCL 324.41305,
324.41309, and 324.47361), sections 41305 and 41309 as amended by
2009 PA 52 and section 47361 as added by 1995 PA 57.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 41305. A person shall not introduce a prohibited species,
  a restricted species, or a genetically engineered or nonnative
  aquatic plant, bird, crustacean, fish, INSECT, mammal, or mollusk,
  OR AQUATIC PLANT unless the introduction is authorized by 1 of the
  following, as applicable:
  - (a) For a fish, by a permit issued by the department of natural resources under section 48735.
    - (b) For an insect or plant, by a permit issued by the

- 1 department of agriculture AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT under section
- **2** 41306.
- 3 (c) For any other species, by a permit issued by the
- 4 department of natural resources under section 41306.
- 5 Sec. 41309. (1) A person who violates section 41303(2) is
- 6 subject to a civil fine of not more than \$100.00.
- 7 (2) A person who violates section 41303(1), or a condition of
- 8 a permit issued under this part, with respect to a restricted
- 9 species is subject to a civil fine of not more than \$5,000.00. A
- 10 person who violates section 41303(1), or a condition of a permit
- 11 issued under this part, with respect to a prohibited species is
- subject to a civil fine of not more than \$10,000.00.
- 13 (3) A person who violates section 41303(1) knowing the
- 14 possession is unlawful or who willfully or in a grossly negligent
- 15 manner violates a condition of a permit issued under this part is
- 16 guilty as follows:
- 17 (a) For a violation involving a restricted species, the person
- 18 is guilty of a misdemeanor and may be imprisoned for not more than
- 19 1 year and shall be fined not less than \$1,000.00 or more than
- 20 \$10,000.00.
- 21 (b) For a violation involving a prohibited species **THAT IS NOT**
- 22 AN AQUATIC SPECIES, the person is guilty of a felony and may be
- 23 imprisoned for not more than 2 years and shall be fined not less
- 24 than \$2,000.00 or more than \$20,000.00.
- 25 (C) FOR A VIOLATION INVOLVING A PROHIBITED SPECIES THAT IS AN
- 26 AQUATIC SPECIES, THE PERSON IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND MAY BE
- 27 IMPRISONED FOR NOT MORE THAN 3 YEARS AND SHALL BE FINED NOT LESS

- 1 THAN \$2,000.00 OR MORE THAN \$100,000.00.
- 2 (4) A person who, with intent to damage natural, agricultural,
- 3 or silvicultural resources or human health:
- 4 (a) Violates section 41303(1) with respect to a restricted
- 5 species or possesses a nonnative aquatic plant, bird, crustacean,
- 6 fish, insect, mammal, or mollusk, OR AQUATIC PLANT is guilty of a
- 7 felony and may be imprisoned for not more than 2 years and shall be
- 8 fined not less than \$1,000.00 or more than \$250,000.00.
- 9 (b) Violates section 41303(1) with respect to a prohibited
- 10 species or possesses a genetically engineered aquatic plant, bird,
- 11 crustacean, fish, insect, mammal, or mollusk, OR AQUATIC PLANT is
- 12 guilty of a felony and may be imprisoned for not more than 4 years
- 13 and shall be fined not less than \$2,000.00 or more than
- **14** \$500,000.00.
- 15 (5) A person who sells or offers to sell a restricted species
- 16 is subject to a civil fine of not less than \$1,000.00 or more than
- 17 \$10,000.00. A person who sells or offers to sell a prohibited
- 18 species is subject to a civil fine of not less than \$2,000.00 or
- **19** more than \$20,000.00.
- 20 (6) A person who violates section 41305 is guilty as follows:
- 21 (a) For a violation involving a restricted species or a
- 22 nonnative aquatic plant, bird, crustacean, fish, insect, mammal, or
- 23 mollusk, OR AQUATIC PLANT, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor
- 24 and may be imprisoned for not more than 6 months and shall be fined
- 25 not less than \$500.00 or more than \$5,000.00.
- 26 (b) For a violation involving a prohibited species or a
- 27 genetically engineered aquatic plant, bird, crustacean, fish,

- 1 insect, mammal, or mollusk, OR AQUATIC PLANT, the person is guilty
- 2 of a misdemeanor and may be imprisoned for not more than 1 year and
- 3 shall be fined not less than \$1,000.00 or more than \$10,000.00.
- 4 (7) A person who violates section 41305 with respect to a
- 5 restricted species or nonnative aquatic plant, bird, crustacean,
- 6 fish, insect, mammal, or mollusk, OR AQUATIC PLANT and who knows or
- 7 should know the identity of the restricted species or that the
- 8 organism, whether a restricted species or other aquatic plant,
- 9 bird, crustacean, fish, insect, mammal, or mollusk, OR AQUATIC
- 10 PLANT is nonnative is guilty of a misdemeanor and may be imprisoned
- 11 for not more than 1 year and shall be fined not less than \$1,000.00
- 12 or more than \$10,000.00.
- 13 (8) A EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (9), A person who
- 14 violates section 41305 with respect to a prohibited species or a
- 15 genetically engineered aquatic plant, bird, crustacean, fish,
- 16 insect, mammal, or mollusk and who knows or should know the
- 17 identity of the prohibited species or that the aquatic plant, bird,
- 18 crustacean, fish, insect, mammal, or mollusk is genetically
- 19 engineered, respectively, is guilty of a felony and may be
- 20 imprisoned for not more than 2 years and shall be fined not less
- 21 than \$2,000.00 or more than \$20,000.00.
- 22 (9) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY TO SPECIES THAT ARE AQUATIC
- 23 SPECIES. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SECTION 41305 WITH RESPECT TO A
- 24 PROHIBITED SPECIES OR A GENETICALLY ENGINEERED CRUSTACEAN, FISH,
- 25 INSECT, MOLLUSK, OR AQUATIC PLANT AND WHO KNOWS OR SHOULD KNOW THE
- 26 IDENTITY OF THE PROHIBITED SPECIES OR THAT THE CRUSTACEAN, FISH,
- 27 INSECT, MOLLUSK, OR AQUATIC PLANT IS GENETICALLY ENGINEERED,

- 1 RESPECTIVELY, IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND MAY BE IMPRISONED FOR NOT
- 2 MORE THAN 3 YEARS AND SHALL BE FINED NOT LESS THAN \$2,000.00 OR
- 3 MORE THAN \$100,000.00.
- 4 (10) <del>(9)</del> A person who violates section 41305 knowing the
- 5 introduction is unlawful, is guilty as follows:
- 6 (a) For a violation involving a restricted species or
- 7 nonnative aquatic plant, bird, crustacean, fish, insect, mammal, or
- 8 mollusk, OR AQUATIC PLANT, the person is guilty of a felony and may
- 9 be imprisoned for not more than 2 years and shall be fined not less
- 10 than \$1,000.00 or more than \$250,000.00.
- 11 (b) For a violation involving a prohibited species or a
- 12 genetically engineered aquatic plant, bird, crustacean, fish,
- 13 insect, mammal, or mollusk, OR AQUATIC PLANT, the person is guilty
- 14 of a felony and may be imprisoned for not more than 4 years and
- 15 shall be fined not less than \$2,000.00 or more than \$500,000.00.
- 16 (11) (10) A person who, with intent to damage natural,
- 17 agricultural, or silvicultural resources or human health, violates
- 18 section 41305 is quilty as follows:
- 19 (a) For a violation involving a restricted species or
- 20 nonnative aquatic plant, bird, crustacean, fish, insect, mammal, or
- 21 mollusk, OR AQUATIC PLANT, the person is guilty of a felony and may
- 22 be imprisoned for not more than 3 years and shall be fined not less
- 23 than \$1,000.00 or more than \$500,000.00.
- 24 (b) For a violation involving a prohibited species or a
- 25 genetically engineered aquatic plant, bird, crustacean, fish,
- 26 insect, mammal, or mollusk, OR AQUATIC PLANT, the person is guilty
- 27 of a felony and may be imprisoned for not more than 5 years and

- 1 shall be fined not less than \$2,000.00 or more than \$1,000,000.00.
- 2 (12) A VEHICLE, EQUIPMENT, OR OTHER PROPERTY USED IN A
- 3 CRIMINAL VIOLATION OF THIS PART OR A RULE PROMULGATED OR PERMIT
- 4 ISSUED UNDER THIS PART THAT INVOLVES AN AQUATIC SPECIES IS SUBJECT
- 5 TO SEIZURE AND FORFEITURE AS PROVIDED IN CHAPTER 47 OF THE REVISED
- 6 JUDICATURE ACT OF 1961, 1961 PA 236, MCL 600.4701 TO 600.4709.
- 7 (13) IF A PERSON COMMITS A CRIMINAL VIOLATION OF THIS PART OR
- 8 A RULE PROMULGATED OR PERMIT ISSUED UNDER THIS PART OR KNOWINGLY
- 9 COMMITS A VIOLATION DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (5) AND IF THE
- 10 VIOLATION INVOLVES AN AQUATIC SPECIES, THE COURT SHALL ORDER THAT
- 11 ANY COMMERCIAL FISHING LICENSE OR PERMIT UNDER PART 473 ISSUED TO
- 12 THE PERSON AND ANY VEHICLE GROUP DESIGNATION FOR A NONPASSENGER
- 13 COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE UNDER SECTION 312E OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE
- 14 CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.312E, PROCURED BY THE PERSON BE
- 15 SUSPENDED FOR 1 YEAR, AND THAT THE PERSON IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO BE
- 16 ISSUED ANY SUCH LICENSE OR PERMIT OR TO PROCURE SUCH A DESIGNATION
- 17 FOR 1 YEAR. IF THE REMAINING TERM OF AN EXISTING COMMERCIAL FISHING
- 18 LICENSE OR PERMIT OR VEHICLE GROUP DESIGNATION FOR A NONPASSENGER
- 19 COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE IS LESS THAN 1 YEAR, THE COURT SHALL ORDER
- 20 THAT THE LICENSE OR PERMIT OR DESIGNATION BE REVOKED AND THAT THE
- 21 PERSON IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO BE ISSUED ANY SUCH LICENSE OR PERMIT OR
- 22 TO PROCURE SUCH A DESIGNATION FOR 1 YEAR. FOR A SECOND VIOLATION
- 23 DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION, THE COURT SHALL ORDER THAT ANY SUCH
- 24 LICENSE OR PERMIT ISSUED TO THE PERSON OR DESIGNATION PROCURED BY
- 25 THE PERSON BE REVOKED AND THAT THE PERSON IS PERMANENTLY INELIGIBLE
- 26 TO BE ISSUED ANY SUCH LICENSE OR PERMIT OR TO PROCURE SUCH A
- 27 DESIGNATION. AN ORDER UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL INDICATE THAT THE

- 1 SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL SUSPEND OR REVOKE THE VEHICLE GROUP
- 2 DESIGNATION FOR A NONPASSENGER COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE WITHIN 7
- 3 BUSINESS DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF THE ORDER. AS IT APPLIES TO A
- 4 COMMERCIAL FISHING LICENSE OR PERMIT UNDER PART 473, AN ORDER UNDER
- 5 THIS SUBSECTION IS SELF-EFFECTUATING. THE CLERK OF THE COURT SHALL
- 6 SEND A COPY OF THE ORDER TO THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND
- 7 SECRETARY OF STATE.
- 8 (14) (11) In addition to any other civil or criminal sanction
- 9 imposed under this section, a person who violates this part is
- 10 liable for any damages to natural resources resulting from the
- 11 violation, including, but not limited to, costs incurred to prevent
- 12 or minimize such damages.
- 13 (15) (12) This part does not apply to activities authorized
- 14 under the Michigan aquaculture development act, 1996 PA 199, MCL
- **15** 286.871 to 286.884.
- 16 Sec. 47361. (1) A person who violates sections 47335 to 47360
- 17 is guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by imprisonment for not more
- 18 than 30 days, or a fine of not less than \$10.00 or more than
- 19 \$100.00 and costs of prosecution, or both. The license of any
- 20 person convicted of 3 violations of this part or other acts or
- 21 parts regulating commercial fishing in any 1 license year shall be
- 22 automatically revoked and canceled for the balance of the license
- 23 year for which issued, and such a revocation prohibits the use of
- 24 boats, nets, or other gear by any person during the balance of the
- 25 year for which the license was issued.
- 26 (2) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (3), IF ANY LICENSE OR PERMIT UNDER
- 27 THIS PART IS ORDERED TO BE SUSPENDED OR REVOKED UNDER SECTION 41309

- 1 AND IF THE DEPARTMENT MAINTAINS A DATABASE OF SUSPENSIONS OR
- 2 REVOCATIONS OF LICENSES OR PERMITS UNDER THIS PART, THE DEPARTMENT
- 3 SHALL NOT ISSUE A LICENSE OR PERMIT UNDER THIS PART TO THE PERSON
- 4 FOR THE PERIOD PROVIDED IN THE ORDER.
- 5 (3) IF A LICENSE OR PERMIT UNDER THIS PART IS ORDERED TO BE
- 6 SUSPENDED UNDER SECTION 41309, THE SUSPENSION REMAINS IN EFFECT
- 7 UNTIL ALL OF THE FOLLOWING OCCUR:
- 8 (A) THE SUSPENSION PERIOD SET FORTH IN THE COURT ORDER HAS
- 9 ELAPSED.
- 10 (B) THE PERSON PAYS THE DEPARTMENT A REINSTATEMENT FEE OF
- 11 \$125.00.
- 12 (4) UNLESS A PERSON'S LICENSE OR PERMIT IS OTHERWISE
- 13 SUSPENDED, REVOKED, OR DENIED, THE LICENSE OR PERMIT IS IMMEDIATELY
- 14 REINSTATED ON SATISFACTION OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (3).
