## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 6. (1) The commission shall do all of the following:
- (a) Subject to subsection (2), operate and manage the Michiganstate capitol historic site.
  - (b) Maintain and restore the state capitol building.
  - (c) Maintain and improve the grounds of the Michigan state capitol historic site.
  - (d) Appoint an individual to manage the day-to-day operations of the Michigan state capitol historic site. The individual appointed under this subdivision is an at-will employee and shall serve SERVES at the pleasure of the commission.
    - (e) Employ staff to carry out the commission's

- 1 responsibilities under **THIS** subsection (1)—and as otherwise
- 2 provided by law. All individuals employed by the commission are
- 3 nontenured, at-will employees. The commission may discipline,
- 4 transfer, demote, suspend, or summarily discharge an employee.
- 5 (f) Contract with any person for purposes of procuring goods
- 6 or services or otherwise carrying out the commission's

- 16 DONATED BY BRASS ROOTS AND HONORING THE RIGHT TO BEAR ARMS UNDER
- 17 AMENDMENT II OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES AND UNDER
- 18 SECTION 6 OF ARTICLE I OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION OF 1963.
- 19 (2) The commission does not have authority and shall not
- 20 exercise control over the internal decisions of the senate or the
- 21 house of representatives related to the allocation of space in the
- 22 state capitol building or the state capitol building parking lot,
- 23 including legislative or staff offices. All decisions concerning
- 24 space in the state capitol building and the state capitol building
- 25 parking lot shall be made according to the rules or practices of
- 26 the senate and the house of representatives.
