Senate Bill 1076 (Substitute S-2 as reported)

## **CONTENT**

The bill would amend the Michigan Vehicle Code to require the driver of a motor vehicle overtaking a bicycle proceeding in the same direction to pass at a safe distance of at least five feet to the left of the bicycle and, when safely clear of the overtaken bicycle, to take up a position as near the right-hand edge of the main traveled portion of the highway as practicable. If it were safe to do so, the driver could pass the bicycle in a no passing zone.

The Code allows the driver of a vehicle to pass another vehicle upon the right of it only under specified conditions.

Under the bill, the driver of a motor vehicle overtaking a bicycle, when otherwise permitted by these provisions, would have to pass at a safe distance of at least five feet to the right of the bicycle.
