A bill to amend 1931 PA 118, entitled

"An act to provide for the administration of oaths, subpoena of witnesses and/or examination of certain books and records by committees and commissions of the legislature,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 4.101).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1. (1) Committees and commissions of or appointed by EACH 1 2 HOUSE OF the legislature may, by resolution OF THAT HOUSE, of the legislature be authorized AUTHORIZE COMMITTEES AND COMMISSIONS OF 3 OR APPOINTED BY THAT HOUSE OF THE LEGISLATURE to administer oaths, 4 subpoena witnesses, and/or to OR examine the books and records of 5 6 any persons, partnerships or corporations PERSON OR ENTITY involved in a matter properly before any of such committees or commissions 7 8 THAT COMMITTEE OR COMMISSION.

(2) THE LEGISLATURE MAY, BY RESOLUTION OF THE LEGISLATURE,
 AUTHORIZE COMMITTEES AND COMMISSIONS OF OR APPOINTED BY THE
 LEGISLATURE TO ADMINISTER OATHS, SUBPOENA WITNESSES, OR EXAMINE THE
 BOOKS AND RECORDS OF ANY PERSON OR ENTITY INVOLVED IN A MATTER
 PROPERLY BEFORE THAT COMMITTEE OR COMMISSION.

(3) SERVICE OF A SUBPOENA AUTHORIZED BY THIS SECTION SHALL BE 6 MADE AT LEAST 7 DAYS BEFORE THE DATE FIXED IN THE SUBPOENA FOR 7 PRODUCTION OF RECORDS UNLESS A SHORTER PERIOD IS AUTHORIZED BY A 8 MAJORITY VOTE OF ALL THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE. THE SUBPOENA 9 SHALL ALSO BE SERVED WITH A COPY OF THE RESOLUTION OR STATUTE 10 11 ESTABLISHING THE COMMITTEE OR COMMISSION AND A GENERAL STATEMENT OF THE SUBJECT MATTER OF THE COMMISSION'S OR COMMITTEE'S INVESTIGATION 12 13 OR INQUIRY.

14 (4) ANY PERSON SERVED WITH A SUBPOENA MAY CHOOSE TO BE
15 ACCOMPANIED BY COUNSEL IF A PERSONAL APPEARANCE IS REQUIRED AND
16 SHALL BE SERVED WITH A NOTICE TO THAT EFFECT.

(5) Any witness who neglects or refuses to obey a subpoena of 17 18 any of such THE AUTHORIZED committees or commissions, or who 19 refuses to be sworn or testify, or who fails on demand to produce 20 any papers, books, or documents touching any matter under 21 investigation, or any witness or attorney who is guilty of any 22 contempt while in attendance at any hearing before any of such THE 23 AUTHORIZED committees or commissions, may be punished as for 24 contempt of the legislature.

26 SECTION DOES NOT CONSTITUTE PUBLIC DISCLOSURE OF THE RECORDS OR
27 FILES. IN THE COURSE OF INSPECTING AND USING ANY RECORDS OR FILES
