

HOUSE BILL No. 4432

April 14, 2015, Introduced by Rep. Chatfield and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled
"Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"
(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 1014.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 1014. (1) AN ON-PREMISES LICENSEE SHALL NOT SELL, OFFER
2 TO SELL, OR ADVERTISE THE SALE OF AN UNLIMITED QUANTITY OF
3 ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR AT A SPECIFIC PRICE UNLESS THE SALE, OFFER, OR
4 ADVERTISEMENT IS IN CONNECTION WITH A PRIVATE FUNCTION.

5 (2) A LICENSEE SHALL NOT SELL, OFFER TO SELL, OR ADVERTISE THE
6 SALE OF 2 OR MORE IDENTICAL DRINKS CONTAINING ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR TO
7 AN INDIVIDUAL FOR THE INDIVIDUAL'S CONSUMPTION FOR 1 PRICE. IF 2 OR
8 MORE IDENTICAL DRINKS CONTAINING ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR ARE SERVED TO AN
9 INDIVIDUAL AT 1 TIME, THE PRICE CHARGED FOR THE SECOND AND EACH
10 ADDITIONAL DRINK MUST BE THE SAME AS THE PRICE CHARGED FOR THE

1 FIRST DRINK.

2 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "PRIVATE FUNCTION" MEANS AN EVENT
3 THAT MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

4 (A) IT IS A PREARRANGED PRIVATE PARTY, FUNCTION, OR EVENT FOR
5 A SPECIFIC SOCIAL OR BUSINESS OCCASION.

6 (B) IT IS ONLY BY INVITATION OR RESERVATION.

7 (C) IT IS NOT OPEN TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

8 (D) THE GUESTS ARE SERVED IN AN OUTDOOR SERVICE AREA OR ROOM
9 THAT IS DESIGNATED AND USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE EVENT.

10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
11 after the date it is enacted into law.
