

HOUSE BILL No. 4805

August 18, 2015, Introduced by Reps. Hoadley, Pagan and Wittenberg and referred to the Committee on Elections.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled
"Michigan election law,"
by amending section 668a (MCL 168.668a), as added by 2004 PA 96.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 668a. (1) The secretary of state shall furnish to each
2 county clerk at state expense for each precinct 2 voter information
3 displays that contain in not less than 18-point type the following
4 information:

5 (a) The hours that the polls will be open.

6 (b) Voting instructions.

7 (c) **INFORMATION ON AN INDIVIDUAL'S RIGHT TO SIGN AN AFFIDAVIT**
8 **BEFORE AN ELECTION INSPECTOR AND BE ALLOWED TO OBTAIN AND VOTE A**
9 **BALLOT IF THE INDIVIDUAL DOES NOT HAVE AN OFFICIAL STATE PERSONAL**
10 **IDENTIFICATION CARD, OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE, OR OTHER**

1 **GENERALLY RECOGNIZED PICTURE IDENTIFICATION CARD TO IDENTIFY**
2 **HIMSELF OR HERSELF AS REQUIRED TO OBTAIN AND VOTE A BALLOT.**

3 (D) ~~(e)~~—Information on an individual's right to obtain a
4 provisional ballot and instructions on how to vote a provisional
5 ballot.

6 (E) ~~(d)~~—Information on the identification requirements that
7 apply to voters who register by mail.

8 (F) ~~(e)~~—Instructions on how to contact the appropriate
9 election official about alleged voting rights violations.

10 (G) ~~(f)~~—Information on the federal and state laws that
11 prohibit fraud and misrepresentation.

12 (H) ~~(g)~~—Information on how to challenge another voter as
13 unqualified to vote.

14 (I) ~~(h)~~—Other information that the secretary of state
15 considers necessary.

16 (2) Upon receipt of the voter information displays under
17 subsection (1), each county clerk shall provide to each city,
18 township, or village clerk, as designated by the secretary of
19 state, 2 voter information displays for each precinct in the
20 county.

21 (3) The city, township, or village clerk shall provide to each
22 precinct 2 voter information displays and an instruction ballot for
23 display at each precinct.

24 (4) Before the polls open on election day, the board of
25 election inspectors in each precinct shall post in conspicuous
26 places in the polling place the voter information displays and
27 instruction ballot required under this section.

1 (5) If requested by an elector, the city, township, or village
2 clerk shall have available a means to provide the information
3 contained in the voter information displays in an alternative
4 format, as prescribed by the secretary of state.

5 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
6 after the date it is enacted into law.
