A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled

"Revised judicature act of 1961,"

by amending section 1307a (MCL 600.1307a), as amended by 2012 PA 69.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1307a. (1) To qualify as a juror, a person shall meet all
 of the following criteria:
 - (a) Be a citizen of the United States, 18 years of age or older, and a resident in the county for which the person is selected, and in the case of a district court in districts of the second and third class, be a resident of the district.
 - (b) Be able to communicate in the English language.
 - (c) Be physically and mentally able to carry out the functions
