HOUSE BILL No. 5156

December 15, 2015, Introduced by Reps. Lyons and Yonker and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

by amending section 1527 (MCL 380.1527), as amended by 2014 PA 484.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1527. (1) The board of each A school district - OR 1 2 intermediate school district - or BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A public 3 school academy shall provide at least 5 days 30 HOURS of teacher professional development each school year FOR EACH TEACHER, 4 DELIVERED IN INCREMENTS OF NOT LESS THAN 30 MINUTES BASED ON 5 GUIDELINES DEVELOPED BY THE DEPARTMENT. BEGINNING WITH THE FIRST 6 SCHOOL YEAR THAT STARTS AFTER THE DEPARTMENT FINALIZES THE 7 GUIDELINES DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION, THE PROFESSIONAL 8 DEVELOPMENT SHALL BE BASED ON STATE BOARD APPROVED STANDARDS FOR 9 10 PROFESSIONAL LEARNING AND ON AN INDIVIDUAL PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR EACH TEACHER THAT IS CONSISTENT WITH GUIDELINES DEVELOPED 11

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BY THE DEPARTMENT. THESE GUIDELINES SHALL MEET AT LEAST ALL OF THE
 FOLLOWING:

3 (A) BE BASED ON THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 3A OF ARTICLE II 4 OF 1937 (EX SESS) PA 4, MCL 38.83A.

5 (B) REQUIRE THAT 50% OF ALL PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROVIDED
6 FOR A TEACHER UNDER THIS SECTION BE PROVIDED EITHER INDIVIDUALLY OR
7 IN A GROUP NO LARGER THAN 30 TEACHERS.

8 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT THE GUIDELINES
9 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) NO LATER THAN 90 DAYS AFTER THE
10 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SUBSECTION.

(3) (2) A state-approved nonpublic school may provide teacher professional development for nonpublic school teachers. The department shall credit this professional development toward the issuance or renewal of a teaching certificate or endorsement to the same extent as professional development provided by a public school is credited for its teachers for those purposes if the department determines that all of the following are met:

(a) The professional development provides substantially the
same program content as professional development provided by a
public school that is credited by the department toward the
issuance or renewal of a teaching certificate or endorsement.

(b) The nonpublic school submits to the same auditing and
documentation requirements for professional development as a public
school.

25 (4) (3) Professional development days HOURS provided under
26 this section ARE IN ADDITION TO PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT REQUIRED
27 UNDER SECTION 1526 AND shall not be counted toward the professional

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1 development required under section 1526.

2 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days3 after the date it is enacted into law.
