A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled

"Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending sections 42 and 726c (MCL 257.42 and 257.726c), as

amended by 2012 PA 529.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 42. "Police officer" means any of the following:

(a) A sheriff or sheriff's deputy.

(b) A village or township marshal.

(c) An officer of the police department of any city, village, or township.

(d) An officer of the Michigan state police.

(e) A peace officer who is trained and **LICENSED OR** certified under the **MICHIGAN** commission on law enforcement standards act,

1 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.601 to 28.616.28.615.

(f) For purposes of enforcing sections 215, 255, 631(1) other 2 3 than for speed by noncommercial vehicle operators, 717, 719, 719a, 4 720, 722, 724, 725, and 726, a duly authorized agent of a county 5 road commission meeting the requirements of section 726c. However, 6 an authorized agent of a county road commission shall only enforce sections 215 and 255 with respect to commercial vehicles. Except as 7 provided in section 726c(2), an authorized agent of a county road 8 9 commission is not required to be LICENSED OR certified as a police officer under the MICHIGAN commission on law enforcement standards 10 11 act, 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.601 to 28.616, 28.615, to enforce any law 12 described in this subdivision.

Sec. 726c. (1) A duly authorized agent of a county road commission when enforcing sections 215, 255, 631(1), 717, 719, 719a, 720, 722, 724, 725, and 726 shall wear a shoulder patch that is clearly visible and identifies the branch of government represented.

(2) A duly authorized agent of a county road commission shall
not carry a firearm while enforcing sections 215, 255, 631(1), 717,
719, 719a, 720, 722, 724, 725, and 726 unless he or she is LICENSED
OR certified as a police officer under the MICHIGAN commission on
law enforcement standards act, 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.601 to
