HOUSE BILL No. 6103

December 6, 2016, Introduced by Reps. Vaupel, Kosowski, Howrylak, Lucido, Santana and Liberati and referred to the Committee on Criminal Justice.

A bill to amend 1989 PA 196, entitled

"An act to abolish the criminal assessments commission; to prescribe certain duties of the crime victim services commission; to create the crime victim's rights fund; to provide for expenditures from the fund; to provide for assessments against criminal defendants and certain juvenile offenders; to provide for payment of crime victim's rights services; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies and departments,"

by amending section 4 (MCL 780.904), as amended by 2015 PA 9.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. (1) The crime victim's rights fund is created as a
- 2 separate fund in the state treasury. The state treasurer shall
- 3 credit to the fund all amounts received under this act and as
- 4 provided by law. The state treasurer shall invest fund money in the
- 5 same manner as surplus funds are invested under section 3 of 1855
- 6 PA 105, MCL 21.143. Earnings from the fund shall be credited to the
- 7 fund.

- 1 (2) The fund shall be expended only as provided in this act.
- 2 Amounts in the fund in excess of the necessary revenue determined
- 3 by the commission under section 3(a) may be used for crime victim
- 4 compensation under 1976 PA 223, MCL 18.351 to 18.368. Any
- 5 additional excess revenue that has not been used for crime victim
- 6 compensation may be used to provide for establishment and
- 7 maintenance of a statewide trauma system, including staff support
- 8 associated with trauma and related emergency medical services
- 9 program activities AND FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF
- 10 CRIME SURVIVOR TRAUMA RECOVERY CENTERS AS PROVIDED FOR IN THE CRIME
- 11 SURVIVOR TRAUMA RECOVERY CENTER ACT. FUNDS USED FOR THE
- 12 ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF CRIME SURVIVOR TRAUMA RECOVERY
- 13 CENTERS UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE CRIME
- 14 SURVIVOR RECOVERY CENTER GRANT FUND CREATED IN SECTION 6 OF THE
- 15 CRIME SURVIVOR RECOVERY CENTER ACT. Not more than \$3,500,000.00
- 16 shall be expended for this purpose from the fund in any fiscal
- 17 year. For the 2014-2015 fiscal year only, not more than
- 18 \$4,800,000.00 shall be expended for this purpose from the fund.
- 19 (3) Beginning October 1, 2018, the amount expended for the
- 20 statewide trauma system from the fund shall not exceed 50% of the
- 21 maximum allowable under subsection (2), unless the amount expended
- 22 is reasonably proportional to crime victims' utilization of the
- 23 statewide trauma system AND THE CRIME SURVIVOR TRAUMA RECOVERY
- 24 CENTERS ESTABLISHED UNDER THE CRIME SURVIVOR TRAUMA RECOVERY CENTER
- 25 ACT.
- 26 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 27 after the date it is enacted into law.
