

# SENATE BILL No. 223

March 19, 2015, Introduced by Senators HOPGOOD, ANANICH, WARREN, HERTEL, SMITH, HOOD, KNEZEK, GREGORY, JOHNSON, YOUNG and BIEDA and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled  
"Michigan vehicle code,"  
(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 811ii.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1           SEC. 811II. (1) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DEVELOP UNDER  
2 SECTION 811E AND ISSUE UNDER SECTION 811F A FUND-RAISING PLATE  
3 RECOGNIZING WOMEN'S HEALTH. THE SECRETARY OF STATE, IN CONJUNCTION  
4 WITH PLANNED PARENTHOOD AFFILIATES OF MICHIGAN, SHALL DESIGN THE  
5 FUND-RAISING PLATES AUTHORIZED IN THIS SECTION.

6           (2) THE WOMEN'S HEALTH FUND IS CREATED WITHIN THE STATE  
7 TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS  
8 FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER  
9 SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL  
10 CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS.

1 MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN  
2 THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.

3 (3) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL TRANSFER THE DONATION MONEY  
4 FROM THE SALE OF FUND-RAISING PLATES RECOGNIZING WOMEN'S HEALTH TO  
5 THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE DONATION MONEY TO THE  
6 WOMEN'S HEALTH FUND CREATED UNDER SUBSECTION (2).

7 (4) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DISBURSE MONEY IN THE WOMEN'S  
8 HEALTH FUND CREATED IN SUBSECTION (2) ON AN ANNUAL BASIS TO THE  
9 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.

10 (5) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL BE THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE  
11 WOMEN'S HEALTH FUND CREATED UNDER SUBSECTION (2) FOR AUDITING  
12 PURPOSES.

13 (6) MONEY DISBURSED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN  
14 SERVICES UNDER SUBSECTION (2) SHALL BE USED TO MATCH THE MATERNAL  
15 AND CHILD HEALTH BLOCK GRANT AND SHALL ONLY BE USED TO SUPPORT  
16 WOMEN'S HEALTH.

17 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
18 after the date it is enacted into law.
